James: Welcome to *LIFE Today*. I'm James Robison. Betty and I are thrilled to have this time with you.

I wish I could, right now wherever you are walk over, take your hand just for a moment, ask if we could just sit down. So if you're walking through, would you just pause and sit down?

And I know some of you are saying, "James, it's early in the morning. I'm not really ready for you to walk in and take my hand. I'm really not!"

I understand that... at what time of day you watch because we start early in the morning on ABC Family, been on Discovery, and then on various inspirational networks like Daystar and TBN and the Inspirational Network, many, many others, Church Network, Word Network; we're there all the way into the evening. You can watch us up until almost midnight. So we really want to give you an opportunity to watch.

I don't know how you're dressed, it doesn't really matter. I wish I could take you by the hand. And Betty, I wish everybody could just see us looking straight at them and letting you know how grateful we are for the opportunity of sharing time with you. You see, we literally come into your home with the hope of sharing a blessing with you.

Now I know some of you say, "Well, James, whenever you and Betty are talking, you always ask us to get involved blessing somebody else." See, we think it's a blessing to bless. And the Lord said he is looking for a nation and a family through whom he could bless the nations of the world. That means through individuals he wants us to bless our neighbors and we really are our brothers' keeper; we really do look out after them. We don't turn it over to somebody else. You've caught that.

But I want you to hear this now, when Beth Moore comes on that's water and that's food, that's nourishment, that's encouragement for you and we have Ravi Zacharias or we have John Eldredge to be a blessing, it is to bless you -- it is to give you a blessing when Chonda Pierce is on; not just to make you smile, but when she talks about the challenges in her life like the depression and the heartache, the things that our viewers identify with. We're coming in to share with you life and love -- *LIFE Today*. Betty, we always encourage our viewers as they receive life to release that life toward others. Our viewers tell us that in releasing the life of God, they experience it.

Betty: You know, James, the complete picture of that is after we have received spiritually and been blessed spiritually, it should be the automatic response to want to give out of that blessing. A lot of times what we ask you to do is to give out with the physical needs of people, of children specifically, and that's where it begins to be able to express Jesus through that physical help that they need so desperately and then we're blessed even more.

James: Well, God says in his Word that "freely you have received so we can freely give." This river that Jesus said, "Out of your innermost being flow rivers of living water," you know a river brings forth life. And the presence of God and his love produces life, everything beautiful, and that's what we want you to see.

Please understand that you are a treasure to the Lord and you are a blessing to me, to Betty, as we seek to bless you. But you have also made it possible, as I've said over and over, for us together to be an answer to someone's prayers. Isaiah 58 is very specific in telling us that God will answer us quickly when we notice the suffering, when we care for the hungry; literally, when you give water to the thirsty.

You know what Jesus said? "When you do it to someone else, you've done it to me." You remember when Jesus said from the cross, "I thirst"? Every one of us would have wanted to give him water. So many of you have helped us do that because when you give water to a thirsty child or a family member, you've done it to Jesus. You've blessed the Lord. Bless the Lord O' my soul and all that is within me. Well, you need to hear from Betty and from me; you bless us by joining hearts and hands to bless others; to bless them in the name of the Lord, to give them something far more precious than anything monetary or materially like material gain.

You look -- you listen and join with Betty and with me and with caring missionaries and say, "What can I do? What is my part today expressing your heart in a very obvious, meaningful, lovingly and effective way? What can I do?" Watch... but listen -- be sensitive to the spirit. You, the viewers of *LIFE Today*, are the most sensitive caring people that we've ever encountered. What a joy to share with you *LIFE Today*.

[Woman speaking foreign language]

James: Boy, "I hate to give my children this water." Okay, "What am I to do?" she said. "I hate to give it to them because everybody in the village is sick." -- Contaminated water.

Well, let me tell you something, I hate the fact that that's all they've got but hate won't fix it, won't correct it, love will.

Betty, it just -- it really grips my heart. I've had a broken heart for souls and lives; I have a broken heart right now for our country, for people in the free world and the third world. I ache -- I ache for all that suffer. Some of the challenges we face are very, very difficult to deal with. It's really going to take supernatural wisdom and intervention. We're trying to help. We'll do everything we can to help you and to bless you but the situation there in that critical area, it's got a simple solution; we just need to drill a water well.

We need to drill in that area where you saw and heard that woman's cry. We really need to drill dozens of water wells and they cost \$4800 a piece. Betty, by joining together we can do that. We can absolutely solve and really deal with that woman's concern if we'll just do what we can to contribute.

Betty: James, you know what stood out with me in watching that is no water, no hope. What can I do to help my child? That's the desperation, heart cry of a mother. Their first love is their child. Their life is their children. What can we do to make the difference? We can be the people, the ones that give them hope. And then we can be the ones to give those precious children a chance at life through pure clean water.

James: The wells cost \$4800. Probably the most joyful letters and comments we hear from people when we walk around, we meet them and they come up and say, "Thank you for not only coming into our home to share hope and help, spiritual inspiration and insight, thank you for giving us the chance of sharing life, of really demonstrating the love of God."

The comment we hear most often, great appreciation for the feeding programs, great appreciation for the rescue life and everything. They say, "James, when we give a freshwater well, because we know every day we're going to get water, clean water." People in the advanced countries buy it in bottles to be sure it is pure. Those people have no access to even water that can help them eliminate disease and give them hope. And when people come to us they say, "\$4800 gift is one of the greatest things I've ever done." Can you do that? Could you give \$1200 or \$2400 toward it? -- Pray somebody will join you and give a well. Or could you give the \$48 and say, "I've got ten. I'm going to touch ten. I'm going to give them hope."

I want you to watch closely and listen to a mother's cry. She has already seen what contaminated water has done. She sees what it is doing, and we really do have the

answer. Please listen to me, this is your chance to totally change someone's future, to really give them hope. Not just words but real hope and real life. Watch closely.

On the mission field:

Translator: My daughter died when she got an infection and diarrhea. The doctor said it was because of the contaminated water we were drinking. She was only eight months old.

We don't have any clean water here. We have to go to the river. We know it's dirty and bad for us but what else can we do? We don't have a choice.

I visit the cemetery to talk to my daughter and to take flowers to her grave. She would be eight years old now. I miss her so much. But what I can do? She isn't here anymore. There isn't anything I can do about it.

I worry about my son's future. We still have to use the contaminated water and sometimes he gets sick like my daughter did. I'm afraid of what might happen.

There's an expression in Spanish that says, "Hopes don't fill you up, but they keep you going." I'm hopeful that God will bring us some help and we can have clean water for my family and the community.

In the studio:

James: Boy!

Betty: Wow! As I listened to that mother, she said her little girl would be eight years old now. The pain's still there, the heartache is still there.

You know, in our country we have the techniques, the facilities, James, the physicians, all the needs that we can afford to have to get help for our child if they were to get ill. We have all the doctors and the nurses that are there ready to help our child get well. But this mother didn't have a choice. You know what the simple need was? Water -- that's not asking much is it? But it is everything to that mom as she watched her little baby die for lack of water -- fresh clean water.

What excites my heart is to know that I can be a part, James can be a part, and you can be a part of making the difference for another mother like her. She has other children, let's make the difference in their life, if we can reach out and give them fresh clean water.

James: You can't imagine how many people have told us that years ago they started doing what Betty and I were led to do. See, we not only went with a heart of a missionary because God led us to the ends of the earth to really touch the areas of pain with God's love and continue always ministering life and love to all of our viewers and people everywhere we would go, but we went out and we addressed pain. And when we came back and said to you, "Would you help?" We had already started. We had made up our mind we're going to help feed the hungry and we're going to help drill water wells if others don't.

I remember, Betty, years ago it was \$3600 to drill a well and we just drill them every time the missionaries bring us the opportunity. Then the cost went up to \$4800 and we said we're going to do it. There isn't a single check that we write that we're any more excited about -- that \$4800 check. And we're going to drill hundreds of wells but you determine how many.

But here's the thing, we've been doing that and it's amazing how many of our viewers said, "You know when we started doing that, it is amazing how it looked like God looked in on our pain, and our need and it was like he just moved on our behalf." I really believe that happens when you release the will of God toward an area of need; oftentimes you find the provision and blessing of God being released toward you. It's like see a river flows out what it receives. That's the nature of a river, it's not a reservoir, it is not a holding tank. What it receives it releases. And Jesus said, "This is how I want you to live."

And many people have told us, even in economic tough times, "God's blessed us because we live to bless. It's amazing. It's like God is waiting to bless." Well, I want to tell you, the stage is set right now for us to reach out in areas of pain and release the love and life of God freely. Sometimes it requires a sacrifice.

There have been times, Betty, when we thought well, man, you know what? This is a little bit of a test. Years ago, it was a real test. But then the more we did it, it was amazing how God just made it possible. He says, "You'll have plenty to give when you begin to release it. I'm going to enable you to give to every good work that I put on your heart."

If you want to help, I'm asking you to dial the number. As you dial it, just go and get a bankcard, just do this -- use the bankcard like a check. That's how you should always use them, like a plastic check. But say, "I want to give a well; \$4800, it may be a big step of faith but I'm going to do it." Or "I want to give toward a well." Wait a minute, we drill most of the wells by people giving \$48 or say \$144 and we add that

together, \$144, as an example, 30 people water for the rest of their life. It's a village, it's a settlement where they have hope and health and clean water.
