Week 22: Spring Mission Feeding
Mission Special #2

Betty: Welcome to *LIFE Today*! This is a very special program because it is very special needs. I'm Betty Robison and this is James.

James: Well, we're going to give you the opportunity of making all the difference in someone's life that one could ever imagine or hope for. Its one thing to have wishful thinking, it is one thing to have dreams and hopes, but it is another thing to really provide reality and meaning in a situation that changes everything. In other words, fulfill the hope -- show them hope's end result: everything is changed, everything is better. We see our dreams and our prayers fulfilled.

I really think sometimes, and I don't want you to misunderstand me when I say this, sometimes we will call for prayer or we will have a prayer meeting, which you know you really can't pray too much, but I think sometimes you can call for prayer and if you're not careful it could be a cop out. It could be dismissing ourselves from actually being an answer to a prayer. O God, do something to change things in our community or our nation or in our church -- but then do you ever put feet to those prayers? Do you ever really seek to become the answer to the prayers prayed if it is possible for you to be the answer?

One thing, Betty, we know for sure. When people are praying, as missionaries do, for the ability to assist the suffering effectively, to point them to life; and when they talk about love, to show them what it looks like -- a demonstration of it. In other words, if they're going to say they care they need to first show them they care before they try to tell them how much they care; tell them about love by showing them love, by demonstrating it. Here's the thing that I pray you'll see. If you want the fullness of God's blessings in your life, seek to release the full impact of those blessing in the lives of others. Be an answer to prayer and watch how rapidly God answers your prayer.

Now, here you're about to witness during the course of this program very real needs and known positive, incredibly transforming, miraculous results as the result of someone expressing love. I want you to listen to a young man who has become quite successful who actually started working with us years ago, ended up going to the mission field, changed his life, has continued to have that life-changing effect even as he continues on in his life and in business. Listen to this incredible testimony because it can very easily be yours.

Announcer: He's the owner of a highly successful tortilla business. But nearly a decade ago Steve Martinez helped feed people in very different and desperate circumstances.

Steve: Well, I worked for *LIFE Outreach*, I worked with them for seven years, was on the mission field feeding children so I got to see where the money was going, how much of an impact it was making.

Announcer: While Steve and his wife Sarah have always supported Mission Feeding, over time much of their attention shifted to raising two young boys until the recently saw a little boy named Lazarus on a *Life Today* program.

Steve: He's five years old and he was laying there in bed – on his deathbed. He was skin and bones. Janice, the photographer for *Life Outreach* snapped some pictures of him and on the camera there is a viewfinder and the little boy asked, "Can I see the picture?"

So she turned the camera to him to show him and he just looked at it. We just lost it because how many times have our kids, my little five year old boy Maverick has asked me, "Daddy, can I see the picture? Can I see it?"

So my wife and I really felt like the Lord showed us a part of His heart for these children and He led me to scripture in Ezekiel that talks about Sodom and Gomorrah.

And the Lord says of Sodom and Gomorrah, "Their sin was being overfed and unconcerned and they did not remember the poor or the needy."

Announcer: As Steve's thriving factory continues to turn out thousands of tortillas each day, he is directing even more of his profits to food factories half a world away.

Steve: These kids don't need a cure. They just need food. My wife and I support *LIFE Outreach* because we have seen the need firsthand and we know how effective *LIFE Outreach* has been in meeting that need.

James: Well, thank you, Lord, first but thank you, Steve and Sarah! Boy, you and I prayed a lot together. Even those prayers, probably led you to Sarah, that beautiful relationship and those two little boys. It really touched my heart, Steve, to just listen to your heart.

And you talked about that little boy. We're facing a situation that is a lot of little Lazaruses right now in Angola. They've had a terrible drought; one of the worst in history and the children are dying of malnutrition. We've got 400,000 children right now that we've located that must be fed. But we've got 100,000 of them in Angola that have really been pressed to the limit, and we've got to raise emergency funds immediately to save those 100,000. And the missionaries suggested, and we thought it was a wonderful suggestion because just that group alone will require a million dollars immediately.

They said, "Do you think you could just ask 1,000 of your viewers to give \$1,000? And then we'd have that 100,000 children covered, that one million dollar need met."

Father, I do pray that, and I agree, that would be a wonderful, wonderful miracle. So I am coming to you and I'm asking you, would you be one of 1,000 to do that? James

But when you and I look out, we see all the missionaries facing all these little children and facing these mothers that are trying to get their child to some food and we realize God wants to take all of them in his arms, he wants the missionaries to be there with not only full hearts but with full hands of assistance. And it can only happen if the people out here will use their hand and have a heart like Steve and Sarah to say we want to care for the other children like we'd care for our own, and make a gift. That's what we're asking you to do.

As heart breaking as that is I want you to know it should be heartwarming to you to know that through your love and through your reaching out and joining hands with us that we can make that difference and we can turn precious little lives like that around if we had the nourishment to give them. And we're depending on you to join with us in doing that.

James: We will actually be stopping a death cycle that is undeniable. So there is the phone number; you see it there appearing on the screen. There is the e-mail, web site where you can go and you can communicate and make the gift. I pray that even as you look in on another very real scene -- and the thing about it is, I pray you'd never look away. You'd look to God and say, "God, how can I be the answer? And how can I offset what these mothers are facing, what these families are facing, these children are facing and what the missionaries watch every day? How can we be the miracle that changes everything?" -- Because you can be and I pray you will.

Announcer: This is an experience we pray you never encounter. A child fighting for

his life; a young boy named Leo. The clinic staff has done everything within their ability to keep him alive. Now his mother, Ilda watches helplessly. She too has done all she can.

>> I cannot lose my boy. He is my youngest of two boys. I can't lose him.

Announcer: It's a case of malnutrition. We'd like to tell you it doesn't happen often -- that it's a rare occurrence but Leo's suffering and Ilda's heartbreak cries out from all over Africa where almost half of child deaths under five are caused by malnutrition. Like so many mothers here, Ilda holds the hand of her suffering child, willing him to live but fearing he's slipping away.

Leo was 3 years old. He died from complications of malnutrition.

In the studio

James: Oh, boy! I'm not... I know I'm not over it yet. We lost our youngest daughter just over a year ago but I watched the mother holding that little boy's hand and Betty, while you were across from Robin and Pastor Willie George and Robin's husband, we're watching as I held our daughter's hand. I held it up and I kissed it. How do you say good-bye? There's no one person watching me right now -- not one that wouldn't have said, we would have changed that -- we would have saved her.

But that didn't happen and it's no one's fault. We don't understand it. For a brief moment cancer won but she's alive forever. But here's the thing, Betty, our viewers can stop that death cycle. They can give those mothers their children.

Betty: I'm grateful that we can shed tears when we see the hurt of others. We can feel the pain that they're going through because I believe as Christians, what we're feeling is what God feels. He weeps when we weep. And I think we should be weeping tears when we see scenes like these, these precious children not getting a chance at life over something that shouldn't be and that's malnutrition. They shouldn't be like this but we have an opportunity to change it when we all come together and join hands together

and hearts together to reach out to these children. Give them a chance. Thank you for caring. Thank you for giving. Thank you for loving these children.

James: Yeah, please, I'm sorry. By the way, you've carried us and our family, as we try to carry you. We really believed as we were looking to see how do we gain from this loss we've suffered? God show us how to bind up the brokenhearted. And weeping is a part of the healing process so don't ever apologize if you've been brokenhearted and grieving over your loss. We care with you. We would weep with you. Jesus did. He kept at the graveside of Lazarus even knowing he was going to bring Lazarus back because the others were weeping. He cares about what we care about.

What I'm asking you to do is to be the miracle for the missionaries. I mean think about this. These missionaries, many of them, have left their homes and their comfort and they planted their lives in the midst of suffering with the hope of bringing healing and life and the love of God -- not just in word but in deed, in action. We're the ones that enable them to do it.

The missionaries say, "Your viewers are the greatest Christians in the world. They're the greatest people in the world because they let us do this great work God's called us to, saving lives and pointing people to the love of God this Christ, and winning them in Christ."

We know we've saved the lives of more than 10 million little children; we, meaning you -- us together. But we've led far more than that to Christ because their hearts were open to receive the message from people who loved them.

Would you dial the number right now please? There are people calling today for prayer. They've got a broken heart and they want someone to pray with them just like we know you're praying for us. James: Boy, it is a miracle! I tell you what, I would not as you can see, our hearts are still very, very tender. When you lose a loved one, and those of you who have lost

family or a child, which is a heavy, heavy load and you realize that we've been spending so many years trying to save people's children, and you've enabled us to do it and we've been very effective.

Boy, when you think about how the outreaches of *LIFE*, our well drilling program has inspired churches and many other ministries to also begin drilling wells so for us to drill between 4,000-5,000 wells that's -- praise God. But the thousands of others who have been inspired to join, praise the Lord for that!

And then when you think about the feeding, to realize that we've saved millions of lives, but our outreach, Betty, when we moved to the schools after the kids got stabilized and we realized the only way to keep them coming to learn how they could have a strong future would be to feed them at school. And the missionaries could see that.

And then it inspired the whole World Food program with Tony Hall who was a democratic congressman in Ohio who loved God but who saw what we were doing with Peter Pretorius and the effect of it, and then shares that. And people are seeing it in all the third-world countries. This is where when we come together and we pray and we do something effective, see we could show our national leaders how to do things effectively, how to address the needs. And you have to do it with love and wisdom and you have to come to the table of reason and compassion and begin to literally extend the hands of God. So that's what you're helping us do.
