James and Betty Robison

James: I'm James Robison and Betty my wife and I welcome you to *LIFE Today*. I like to think that every program we do is important to you and if you watch *LIFE Today* you know that it's important to people around the world, whether we're giving them a fresh water well to totally change everything in the area where they live, whether we're feeding the malnourished that are dying, some of them oftentimes during crises situations, catastrophic events, but whatever we do, when you come to *LIFE Today*, you see us sharing life.

And, Betty, we're always offering freedom to people. The freedom that Jesus said he came to offer.

But now, I want you to understand to today, and I'm going to read a passage, and especially one particular verse, that will indicate what we believe this should mean to you and everyone you love. I would simply say this very pointedly. Let me just try to say it as though I were seated right there in the room with you. If you love your family, if you just love life and you want to be able to live it fully, if you care at all about the future, and I don't think you're going to think about the future when Jesus gets us out of this mess.

What if you could have the presence of the Lord Jesus and God the father looking over us now in such a way that we feel sheltered and secure? Would you not want that for your children? Do you not want some sense of security? If you care about that?

I believe what we're sharing today, and I've said to you many times, you've prayed me into this place because I've watched you so many times reading the scriptures in the morning and weeping over what you saw God offering and it was like we were forfeiting it and we were losing the precious things that had meant so much to us in our life's journey. Why were you weeping? Why were you concerned? What was it you were concerned about?

Betty: Well, I see things that are going on in our world and our country, specifically, that really break my heart. I feel like the values and the foundations which you and I

believe in, God based, on God's foundations, on God's truths, are being torn apart and so many fragmented and so many ways.

The families being torn down, the marriages being torn down, the church is being attacked and I feel like that we have an opportunity now, with what we're doing here, to bring some of that back into the center of where it should be and God as center. I'm not talking about religion, I'm talking about relationship and life and standards and truths and values that we believe in.

James: It's where we love God and love our neighbor. It's where we really not only want the best for our lives but we really want the best for others.

And let me ask you something! Who knows best? You know, there used to be a television program, Father Knows Best. Well, let's just go ahead and settle the issue. There is a father who knows best and he is the creator. And he not only wants the best for us, he knows the best.

Let me tell you what he says, there is a river that flows from the throne of God. That's in the last chapter of the Revelation. When I was praying, because I think *you* pray, other church leaders have prayed. Listen, both Catholic and Protestant praying for God to reveal the father. I mean, really praying. Isn't that amazing?

And you know how some of you went on hold right there when I just simply said Protestant and Catholic because we have become so tribal, it's like Democrat and Republican, left and right. You know, it's not really left or right, it's up or down. We either look up to God and we're lifted up or we look away from God and we're coming down.

And we're losing freedom. And I really believe you care about it. We don't have to lose it! I mean, if God offered it and Jesus said he came to set captives free and to give us freedom and he said the truth will make you free and if you abide in it you will live free. I want you to listen to what he impressed upon my heart because people are praying.

He spoke to me in my prayer time. He said the river is already flowing but it's being fed by tributaries. And I want you to listen to this. I mean, just listen. Just kind of hang on and listen to what God says! There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the family of God, the people of God. Appropriately translated even, the church, the redeemed of the Lord, those that have been born from above supernaturally. There's a stream -- streams -- it goes on to say God is in the midst of her. She will not

be moved. We are standing on a rock solid unshakable foundation. You can only build on a rock, not sand. Too many lives and marriages and futures and even our nation has moved to the instability of the sand. God will help her when the morning dawns. The nations made an uproar and the kingdoms tottered and he raised his voice and the earth melted but the Lord of host is with us and the God of Jacob is our stronghold. We can be secure. There is security.

Let me tell you what God revealed and this is because of a lot of people praying. He has literally sent and set on this earth and in the church streams of wisdom -- think about this, streams of enlightenment, of inspiration, of understanding. Among those greatest followers of the Lord, when King David was king, they had understanding of the times, they were the men of Issachar. God knows we need that.

The prophet said, "My people perish for lack of knowledge." The knowledge of what? The knowledge of God! The knowledge of truth! The knowledge of freedom!

Betty, in answer to that prayer God led us to launch The Stream. It's a website. I am now looking back several days from what you'll see if you go. Stream.org

Now there's the address, right there. Above the address, Stream.org, that's all you need to type in on your table computer, on your iPad, your iPhone, whatever device you have, you'll see the stream at the top, the Logo. You'll see a list of various categories. Alright?

The US, it could also reference us. That's just who we are. How does it relate?

The Globe, Family, Sci-tech, the Arts, God -- You'll notice God is in the very center of everything. He's in the center of the universe. Everything is held together --

Listen, every column, every page is God's. We want it under God, overseen by God, and led by God.

Education, Fun, Opinion, More.

And then you will see the Voices of some of the most brilliant people in the nation. And they're writing about things that matter. There's a very interesting column right here by Scott Walker. Now, this was a while back but it's still where you can find it. He asked a question: Scott Walker, how pro-life is he? It's written by one of our editors. And you say is this a political piece? No, what this is, this is a pro-life question and

what he points out is that you can say you're pro-life, that you believe life begins at conception and that all life is equally precious and valuable --

And by the way, we will never overcome the tragedy of abortion by merely focusing on a law, however bad it is because only good thinking and people who understand the right, what is right, are going to establish the kind of laws and policies that are the most meaningful that offer the greatest protection, not just for the life of the unborn but for all life.

So here's what he pointed out. He wasn't pointing a finger. He was saying if you say you're something but you surround yourself with people that don't believe that --

And see, I had this discussion back when President Reagan had moved into the White House with a very strong pro-life position, and yet one of the first things he did was appoint Sandra Day O'Connor. I actually had this discussion with Ed Meese, that all who know the truth about the tendencies of this potential justice, she won't stand for those things you hold precious, like the preciousness of life. It was true!

In other words, the decisions a person makes when you put someone else in power, if that person doesn't hold those convictions, (you need to understand this about leadership) when you get in the political circle you're surrounded by advisers and counselors that can cut you off from all the truth they desperately need to hear.

So, when you go to The Stream, what we're trying to show you are those things that matter to us today and from now on. You've got the inspiration page, which is just one article after another of inspiration. This particular one I actually am sharing about healing for heartbreak and pain. And we start out referencing the loss of our daughter. And then we go on to talk about how Jesus came to bind up the brokenhearted.

Betty, I had preached and taught so often on freedom, which is so vitally important, but sometimes we overlook the need to bind up the brokenhearted. I think one of the reasons that some of the best thinkers and people we would call conservative, economic conservatives and others for instance; I think they don't know how to look at the pain where people live.

I've said many times to people who really think straight, you don't communicate with the average person. You don't -- Conservatives have not communicated well with minorities, people who understand the imperative economic stability and balance of sane thinking. They don't seem to be able to communicate with the average people.

Well, The Stream is going to help you know that Jesus, in fact, came to bind up the brokenhearted. Any person –

You know, we just say how do we find a good leader? A good leader -- Now, don't you miss what I'm saying! A good leader, first of all, has God's interest at heart and recognizes that God is interested in you. Not just in one particular class or single issue but totally interested in you, not only the unborn but what happens to those after they're born.

And I'm going to tell you something, if we ever find leaders who love God and love their neighbor and don't use it as a campaign slogan, but it's the depth of their soul who they are. Well, so when I talk about binding up the brokenhearted we had to have our heart -- our hearts are still being bound up and every time someone expresses love or concern and wants to hold our hurt it's comforting. Well, we need to hold deep in our hearts the concern of every person who is poor.

And by the way, we've got a lot of programs in place that are not helping the poor at all, in our nation. They're actually hurting the poor. They're making them victims, they're making them easy to manipulate and own and control to their own demise. So, you see, if we don't think straight because we're walking straight, we're looking to God and the God who says I'm first, and then you look at others and you love your neighbor and you care about them like you care about yourself. In other words, you won't just throw money at them to try to buy them and own them and control them, you'll say what can we do to really help them?

That's why, Betty, I've been telling some of the wealth creators and the people that know how to do what's best to create opportunities and jobs, focus your great wisdom on inspiring people, teaching people, training people how they too can find their dream or their future in a free state, a free nation, where freedom prevails.

I want to tell you something, all the freedoms that are precious to us are being threatened right now: freedom of expression, unless you express what a certain group wants you to express. You don't ever impose faith on people. You don't impose God on people. You lift him up so high and so clearly that people see how wonderful he is, how much he loves them wherever they are. But you do not submit to any new form of pharaoh or dependence upon Uncle Sam, who will never be our father, or some big promising powerbase, but God, and maintain freedom.

The Stream is a gift, the result of prayer, for all of you who love freedom. Just look at some of the columns, just glance at them. If you click on any one of them, click on the

God. In the God column you will see many things coming up that are very much important to people who believe God is important. You will see the recommended and you hit recommended and that will come up. And you can scan all of those things that are there.

Go to the opinion and you will see that the editors and commentators who are writing and sharing an opinion, something we should be concerned about. Just scan it. See, what you'll see, you'll find stories that you will want to direct people to. For instance, here's one of them that was very, very popular with people who love God and love life. "Poll Shows More Americans are Fed Up with Abortion Policies than Ever Before." Now the major media will not likely tell you that but you can go there and then when you see that story you can actually then share that everywhere you can. And then people, your friends will be going to The Stream and encourage your friends to send people to The Stream because you'll get current news, breaking news. It's important to people who love faith, family, and freedom and who want to protect it. You will learn how to protect it because with the bad news we give you the good news.

Betty, it's just exciting what people are seeing.

>> He raped her and threw her into the sewer drain. We searched the entire night and found her dead.

Announcer: While Raine's loss will forever haunt her she's fighting to protect her treasured ones who remain. But it's something she cannot do alone. With your help, Raine and her children can be provided the safety and security they so desperately need.
