Spring Mission Feeding special 2

James: We welcome you to *LIFE Today*. I'm James Robison; Betty and I are thrilled to have an opportunity to share with you life every day.

I would really like for you to understand that when we come into your home and we bring these incredible guests, Betty, it is like sometimes we're able to discover this magnificent, beautiful scenery or this incredible, fruitful plant that is maybe growing blossoms and blooms and we see, and you can see the blooms in the desert. Here in Texas we've got wildflowers in the spring that are magnificent. President Lyndon Johnson's wife, Lady Bird Johnson, I carried her groceries out when I was 12-13 years old to the car when she would buy groceries at the store where I had my first job, starting at 12. She encouraged the planting of wildflowers. When you see them, it is just beautiful. Sometimes you'll be out in a setting where you see something bloom that you think my goodness! And you want to take a picture of it.

Some of the most spectacular books and magazines that you look at, I think of Arizona Highways, you may think there's a lot of desert in Arizona but boy, they've got beautiful pictures! Colorado -- beautiful pictures! You'll see something growing that you just wish everyone could see.

Well, this is what *LIFE Today* does. We bring into your living room, we bring into your home or wherever you watch some of the most beautiful, fruitful people on the planet, showing you the life and love of God every day; that's why we call it *LIFE Today*. And Jesus came that we might have life and have it abundantly; not some religious existence but a relationship that is so meaningful, Betty that it's actually beautiful.

When you see people love... You know some of the hottest videos on YouTube are people loving a pet or having fun with a pet. Let me tell you something. The greatest scene is when you can see what love does to pain and suffering and misery to make all things new. And do you know this -- think about this a

moment -- the Bible says, "A little child will lead them." Some of the greatest inspiration in our lives has come from children -- not just our grandkids. We've got 11 grandchildren and we wouldn't mention them if they were just your regular every day ordinary grandkids. These are special grandkids! And we just love them, and we just like to talk about them.

But sometimes, you'll see a child do something and that moves more than mountains, it moves hearts, it moves people, it moves men and women and families to do something very special. I want you to look at a little five-year-old boy. I want you to hear his heart. He really did get all dressed up for you. Watch.

Abbi: So I watch *LIFE Today* quite often, actually right before I go to bed. I have the children with me. Ryan, my five year old was very, very upset that these kids did not have any food and they didn't have any clothes.

Ryan: I was watching TV one day, at night, when I was going to bed and I saw them eating dirt. I felt bad for them.

Pastor Smith: Ryan has this heart for helping people and he said, "I'm going to give all of my money for cranberry harvest to them. Those kids need to eat -- that's not fair that they can't eat."

Ryan: First I had \$25 and then I wanted to send it to Africa.

Pastor Smith: I said, "Well, Ryan, I think this is a really good story. Would you be willing to get up in front of the whole church and share what you're going to do?" He said, "Yeah!"

Abbi: He got up on stage and spoke about what he was doing and how he was going to send all of his money to Africa. And he ended up getting \$833 in donations that day. So that night he sent \$1,000.

Eric: I thought we'll go to church and people in the congregation will give and they will help and he'll raise a couple hundred bucks. And God just grabbed that money and multiplied it. Ryan was able to feed a lot of kids with that money. I'm just thankful that God's working in my son.

Pastor Smith: It's already beginning to have that ripple effect. Others are jumping in. He told me Sunday, "Yeah, I got more money to give." I don't foresee this being a onetime gift for him. It could be a lifestyle.

Announcer: Thanks to five-year-old Ryan many children are going to receive food but there are still countless other children in desperate need of food throughout remote areas of Africa. Please join Ryan's heart to give and help those who are in need today.

James: Ryan, I love you buddy! I want to say to all of you in Yakima, Washington, years ago I preached a crusade there, and all of you in the greater Seattle area, and all of you on the west coast and all over America, and all over the United Kingdom and Australia, wherever you are, it doesn't matter, I want you to know that I believe you're going to respond to Ryan. I'd love to be able to call Ryan and say, "Today, Ryan, you won't believe how much people called in today because you touched their heart." And we will.

Ryan, we'll let you know.

So I say to everybody watching, you know that we've been feeding now for more than 20 years these precious people and saving millions of lives. The last count, we were told by the African government officials who kind of kept up with what was happening, that we'd saved over 11 million children's lives and their family. That's a lot of people.

And I'd love to call today and say, "Ryan, here's how much came in today online LifeToday.org or they dialed the number there on the screen and they knew..." He gave initially \$1,000 and they let us know, he is going to keep sending more. So I have an idea he is working right now.

But you're working too now, Ryan because we're telling people all over the world what God put on your heart and I think it will be on their heart, and they're going to be going to the phone or going online right now.

Here's the program. He gave \$1,000 to start with but he's not finished. But that feeds 100 children. And when you think about the fact that we've got a matching gift right now, that's 200! So that amount doubled right now, little Ryan already has directly touched 200 children with the food they need, and their families -- and then with what you do today. Think about it, \$30, \$50, or \$100, this is the normal amount.

I think I've tried to make it real clear. I've tried to break it down where you understand it; \$30 we can feed three children for the next several months and we ask you to help twice a year. We come sometime in the spring, early summer and in the fall, going into the winter months, and we ask you to help. \$30 will feed three but now it's six because we've got \$400,000 matching gift; that means it doubles. \$50 feeds 5, now it's 10. \$100 feeds 10, now it's 20. So maybe you give \$1,000.

Maybe you say, "I'll tell you what I'll do, I'll just go ahead and match Ryan. I'll give another \$1,000." And then that's going to be doubled and we just jumped again to a couple hundred more people just from your gift.

So the thing is, like Ryan saw it, I want to send it to Africa. I want to send it to those kids that don't have what I've got. He had his own \$25; he gave all of it right up front. It was kind of like the widow's mite but this is a little boy's -- this is his all.

Betty: James, one thing I really, I was listening to Ryan, one thing I thought was so important was even as a little five-year-old boy, he knew that it couldn't just stop with this one time gift. He said, "We need to feed them forever." It's continuing; that's why we continually ask you. They don't just eat that one time and then quit eating. They need food to continue to get to them so that they can nourish their little bodies. I would like to ask you one question, would you help Ryan feed the children? I will! I hope you will.

James: And it is forever too. That's a huge word because Jesus gives us life forever that starts now. We don't die to get eternal life. We receive Christ and we receive eternal life. Betty and I are going to heaven. We have a beautiful daughter in heaven. We know right where she is. She is praying for us, I know and she is rejoicing over the good things. But we already have heaven in us and we go to heaven. We want people to go.

And the thing about it is, with what Ryan is supporting and the outreach here with the mission programs in the Sudan and all over Africa, to the 425,000 right now that we've found in crisis situations, we're going to tell them how to have life forever. And when you show people the love of God they're ready to hear about the love of God because they've witnessed it in action. It's not just loving in word but in deed.

So I'm asking you to go online right now or to go to the phone. You know we're going to send you the incredible teaching, *Heirs to the Kingdom*: Embracing the riches of sonship -- children of God! On the mission field

Peter: We're with people here who really have some desperate, desperate needs. The thing to understand is they've lost everything. Before they actually ran from the conflict they had cattle, their children drank milk from those cattle, they had crops that they planted that they harvested but when they fled from the conflict they left everything behind. Their houses were burned. They took nothing with them, literally having to fend for themselves.

When I spoke with these people just a little while ago and asked them, "Have you lost any children through starvation or malnutrition?" More than 60% of them responded and said, "Yes." They had lost at least one child.

You know that... to me, it's not right. These are innocent kids. These are people who are caught in a situation where they haven't been able to grow crops. It's not that they're lazy. It's not that they don't try and fend for themselves. They haven't been able to grow crops. And they, right now, are sitting in such a precarious position that they fear that their other children are going to starve to death.

We have to help these people. We cannot just walk away from here and turn our back. It doesn't take a lot from each person to help a little boy like this, to actually change his life. Because you know what he needs? He just needs a bowl of food. That's not complicated. It's so simple. He just needs a bowl of food, and you can provide that bowl of food. If you'll do that, we will make sure that it gets to these people. So please, please respond and respond now.

James: I hear you, Peter, and I know what that appeal means. It means that we can take these heat-resistant bowls that viewers like you insisted that we make for the children because you had seen them too many times with these old tin cans that the soup would burn their hands and

then you watched them with the plastic bags that the food would burn through and fall into the dirt, and those children would actually try to get it out of the dirt.

So what we're doing, as Peter is asking, is we're going to send them the food but we're also hoping we can send the bowls there, 25,000 children there in the Sudan, if you gave each one of them a bowl, that's \$25,000. There may be somebody who will say, "Well, I'll do that." It is possible. There are people so filled with love that have prospered and been blessed who do that.

And the incredible thing is, Betty, if they did it now it would be doubled and we'd have 50,000 bowls.

Betty: James, not only will it help to keep their little hands from being burned, their little fingers, and they hold it safely but it helps the missionaries too because there are lines on the inside that gives them different levels that they can dish out.

Why, you say? Because sometimes more kids than you expected show up. -- Because why? They're hungry. So it gives them something to work with so that they make sure that each child that stands in that line all day long can get something. So thank you!

James: We've seen it when it ran out and the children are literally crawling in the barrels and scraping it trying to get something. We're trying to keep that from happening. So everything works with a purpose and it's all provided by people just like you.

So if we meet the need right now, \$30, \$50, \$100 feeds three, five or ten children. And we're asking you, like if you want to feed like three, five, or ten tack on \$3 for the three children or \$5 or \$10 for that level that you're at. What you do will be doubled. So it will suddenly go from 100 children, if you give \$1,000 or 10 children if you give \$100 to be doubled to 200 or 20; and the amount of bowls, if you tack on the extra money for the number of children you feed, that will also be doubled.

So right now we have an incredible opportunity to be an answer to the prayer and the plea of missionaries like Peter Pretorius, and the pleas of the mothers and the families that so desperately need our help.

I'm asking you right now, and we're moving into the latter part of this mission feeding emphasis, we really need to hear from all of you. Be an answer to prayer. Let's be able to give Ryan an amazing report that will give great joy to the missionaries as well as those who have need. I want you to watch and listen and just see if God is not speaking to you even as some of you are moving to the phone right now or you've gone to get your laptop or however you can go online and make that gift. Watch closely.

James: You never get over some losses, you live through them. As I was watching them just holding the little hand of the children, I'm sorry, but I remember holding our daughter's hand, lifeless -- the toughest moment of my life.

Here's the thing. I don't believe there is a single person watching that wouldn't have said, if we could have turned that back for you, James, we would have. I know you mean it -- I know you mean it and I thank you. And for the prayers that have held me and Betty up for the nearly two and a half years since we lost our beautiful little girl, mother of three teens. I know you mean that. That didn't happen, she is alive.

But here's the thing. What we saw, it can happen. We can stop the process now. Right now! It is not wishful thinking. It's not I wish I could have done something. We can! And we can save the lives of thousands and thousands of precious -- somebody's child, somebody's family.

Betty, I believe our viewers, in response to the heart of God to love and to give life, I believe they're going to do it.

Betty: We know that for this disease, this problem, there is a solution, there is a cure. This is something that we can be a part of solving the problem of the death of these children by starvation. We can do something about it. That should bless our hearts. That should fill us with a zeal and a love and a hope to want to reach out and say, "As many as we can -- as many as we can! Lord, help us do it." I hope you will help us do it.

James: I'm believing that you will. I want to thank you. I'm going to be so excited to put
