Water for Life Special #1

James and Betty Robison

James: I want to welcome you to a very special *LIFE Today* program. Betty and I are always thrilled to share our time together. I want to give you a very definite promise that you can count on. Oftentimes people say things that we hope will come true or at least hope are true, and yet we find so much disappointment. There's not a person that I've ever met that doesn't have some hopes for something perhaps better; maybe for a dream or a wish to be fulfilled or how about a prayer answered?

Well, let me read you what you can count on because this is God's Word. God says if you reach out and care for those in need that you will call and the Lord will answer. And he will say, "Yes, I'm here" and he will quickly reply. He says if you notice someone else that has a need and you respond to that need, God himself will take notice and will respond to your call, your prayer, your need. Now, they don't always come the way we want them to come or in the time frame we wish but God will respond.

Now I want you to listen to this: Remove the yoke of oppression. Stop pointing your finger and spreading rumors! Stop adding to the dissension and to the division and to the strife. Blessed are the peacemakers. They do see God. It's amazing what happens to the meek! They inherit the earth -- they're teachable. Feed the hungry -- listen to this -- help those in trouble.

And then, Betty, he says your light will shine out from the darkness -- and we have plenty of it - - and the darkness around you will be as bright as noon and the Lord will guide you continually giving you water when you're dry and restoring your strength -- and listen to this because this is fantastic -- you will become like a well-watered garden.

What does that mean? That means when you have water and light you're going to be fruitful, you're going to be blessed and you're going to be a blessing. There is not a fruitful garden, there is not an area of beautiful blooming flowers that are not a blessing to the people who see them. So when you become a well-watered garden you're a blessing. That is precisely what God wants us to be.

Well, you know, Betty, right now we're going to give our viewers an opportunity to do what God referenced in Isaiah, that was chapter 58, when he says if you take care of people that have need.

I think you're going to recognize this man, and you're going to remember. Now if you reflect back, you're going to remember he had lost a daughter, he had lost a grandchild all because of unclean water. You want to see what love does? You want to be a part of it? You want to become that well-watered garden and see your prayers answered? Well, watch what happens when you become an answer to prayer.

On the mission field

Announcer: Last year, the *LIFE Outreach* mission team met Vaughn and his grandchildren in their remote village in Cambodia. Vaughn showed the team where his family gathered their drinking water. While introducing his grandchildren, Vaughn broke into tears and shared how his daughter and precious grandson had died because of that contaminated water.

And now a year later, *LIFE's* mission team returned to Vaughn's village and found that his tears have turned into tears of joy. Mission: Water for Life was able to successfully drill and install a new water well, literally in Vaughn's back yard! Vaughn, his grandchildren, and the other villagers now have safe drinking water and their lives have been transformed!

>> Last year, your group came here and saw my problem with dirty water. You promised to help me and now I have a clean water well. I feel like I have been reborn and I have a new hope. Thank you to all those who helped us and especially, thank you to Jesus.

In the studio

James: Love it! That literally... it wasn't tap water in his little modest dwelling but it was right there, so to speak in his backyard.

Betty: It was like gold to him, James. Fresh water for those he cares about and loves. As you shared earlier, when we reach out and we extend a hand of hope to someone, hope springs up. It is contagious! And when we see that, the results of what many of you have contributed to because of your love, because you care about these children that are dying because of diseased water. Thank you so much. You see what happens -- the goodness of God and hope springs up.

James: We've always wished... and it is impossible to do because of the areas where we spend so much of our time on the mission field. We actually were in much of the time in very remote

areas where it is difficult to take people. Many people come to us and say, "I want to go to the mission field!" Well, not if you knew where you were going to have to stay because we go in very difficult areas.

Sometimes we work in the areas around the big population centers too, wherever there is a crisis, we're going to be there. But out in those remote areas, and you go into those places and you give people water and you give them hope and you give them help, it changes everything and it opens their hearts and their minds to hear about the source of love that inspired you to reach out and to give them water and give them hope and give them help.

Now here's what we want to ask you to do. We come to you twice a year and we ask you to help us drill water wells. Now we've really expanded our goal and last year we were able to reach the goal and even exceed it. This year we're setting a goal to drill another 500 wells, at least 500. We've already targeted the areas, the missionaries are there, we're confident the water sources are there, attainable, and we can still keep the cost at \$4800.

Now, many of you have joined in prayer asking God to enable you every year to do what we prayed we could do and Betty and I have been able to do this, to drill a well every time the ministry points to another opportunity. Some of you are targeting that.

Others of you are just getting started and you're saying, "Well, we'll help a little." I'm thrilled that we've got many people who say, "I give \$1200 and I start praying, God give three more to join me and we've got a well" -- we've got another \$4800 or \$2400 and pray for a matching gift from someone. But the majority of our gifts come from people who give \$48 or \$144.

Now here's what I want you to do. I want you to listen very closely to a woman that I believe when I first heard this, it moved me and touched my heart as much as anything I've ever seen.

Betty, I remember your response when you saw this precious mother named Roen. Please watch this very prayerfully and I think you're going to be moved to very positive action.

Announcer: She moved so slowly. No, she hardly moved at all. And no tears fell because that well had run dry. While no picture of health, Roen has been drained of life -- the kind of life found in your role as a mother. Death came. It took from Roen but then it took again and again and again.

Subtitles:

>> I had 12 kids, but seven of them died. I only had a little breastmilk, it wasn't enough. I had no choice but to supplement with water.

Announcer: In this heat, the average person can survive only a few days without water. Though this water might extend a life, it eventually takes it, especially children because their immune system is too weak for that fight.

Subtitles:

>> This is our only water source. It feels like something has been taken from my heart, like I have no more soul. I think I'm going crazy.

Announcer: Trauma has taken its toll but because the water which took her children is still their only source, Roen knows that unless something is done to provide clean water that at any moment she could lose all that remains.

In the studio

James: That is positively one of the most touching, heart-wrenching appeals and let's say testimony of a painful journey I've ever heard.

Betty, we've just passed the anniversary of our daughter's funeral and her death after Christmas, and that's one child.

By the way, I don't reference that to try to cause you to extend some kind of sympathy to us. I say it because you understand at least to some degree, and especially if you've lost a child, the pain and the heartache. I bring it up because your prayers and your love have helped heal our hearts.

But at the same time, we feel the heartache of someone who has lost a loved one -- we really do because we know firsthand. And when I see a mother that has lost seven children and she's concerned she's going to lose the others, Betty, I want to do anything I can to help.

Betty: I can't even imagine, James, the heartache and the heaviness that you and I have experienced through the loss of our daughter, one child -- seven children? From one heartache to the next, and possibly more, if she doesn't get the help she needs. She's done all she can do. She has no other source to go to except the contaminated, diseased water. And it must break her

heart every time she dips her bucket or whatever container she's got, and she brings that water up and she knows it's going to go into her children's bodies, it's got to be breaking her heart but she can't do anything else. They have to have water to even survive a little while.

So what can we do? We can drill the water wells. Please help us do this. If this were your children, what would you want? What would you want someone to step in and do for you?

James: We're talking this entire program about being an answer to prayer and yet, I told you that God has promised that when you become an answer to someone's prayers, your prayers are answered. That wasn't the promise of some government representative or some leader; that's the promise of God.

I've got to be honest with you, when I see a situation like Roen where's she's lost her children, could lose others, and I know I can go in and correct it, I don't even give a thought about what's in it for me or what's coming back to me. Excuse me, I know we're pretty well focused and I understand. Everybody has to have a legitimate self-interest; not selfish interest, a self-interest and an interest in your family's well being. That's natural. But if we think I'm only going to help somebody else because I know it is coming back to me in some way, there's something wrong with that type of thinking. What if we just gave life and benefit and blessing and we never even gave a thought to ourselves? I think there would be some kind of freedom and release in that that would be amazing.

This is the emphasis that if we wake up we become the expression of God's life and God's love right here right now on planet earth. We can show the world what Jesus looks like. "Father, forgive them," he said. "They don't even know what they're doing." These are the people that spite him, spit on him and scourged him. Hung him on the cross! God forgive them. In other words, they are held captive; they're in bondage. "I've got so much love I'm going to take their sin, I'm going to take their punishment, I'm going to take their penalty, I'm going to give them life." He was thinking about us.

Can we not look over and see someone that has need of water and just say, "I want to save that mother's other children. I want to save the people in that village." If you will dial that telephone number or go to LifeToday.org and make the best gift you can, you're going to be giving the greatest gift, you're going to give those people a chance at life and we're going to tell them about the life that can be found in Christ because we love them. We want to help them and meet them where they are and then we want to show them the love of God expressed in Christ.

Would you dial that number? Would you use your bankcard like a check? If you write a check, make it to *LIFE*. But please, please call us and say, "I'm going to be an answer to that woman's

Announcer: For a young mother living in poverty in a remote Cambodian village, life can be hard. This mother's name is Tang. If she's lucky enough to get a job in a rice field she will make a couple dollars a week that will maybe buy a little food for her and her family. But buying clean water to drink is a luxury she can't afford. So Tang has no other choice but to gather water from the muddy pond in her village.

James: That is so beautiful! Janice is our floor director when we do our television program,

unless she's on the mission field, and she's been going now between 20-25 years to the mission field. And she goes with the love of Jesus in her heart. Betty, to see her do what she does so often but to actually be able to capture it, leading that lady, Tang to the Lord is beautiful.

Betty: So special! James, I looked at that young mother and she wants so badly for her only living child to survive; seen one loss of her son -- her baby, her precious son that she loves so much. And I just think about... she said she knew that the water was bad for her children but she had to give it to them because it's all they've got.

It's just like I remember when our children were small. If they were outside playing and they got near the street we would say, "No, no, no! Don't go out there. You'll get hurt."

She cannot say that to her children as they dip that water in their hands and drink it. No, no, no! Don't drink it. Because it's all they've got. James, that breaks my heart because she has no other source to go to.

James: Just to hear you talking, as a mother and referencing what Betty could do so well, to know how much we want to protect our children and our grandchildren, can you not identify? Do you not want to, as I say so many times, be an answer to someone's heart cry, someone's need -- an answer to someone's prayer? Would you? Would you drill a water well for that mother and all of the hundreds of mothers that she represents, and even the thousands and thousands of children that desperately need clean water? Something we take for granted.

And people here in the United States, and in Canada, and all over North America and throughout the world are so concerned about clean water that oftentimes they're trying to buy bottles of water just to guarantee maybe it is a little bit cleaner. We're so fortunate.

Would you not give a well of water to a village, a community, a little population center? Remember, \$48 you're going to give ten people -- ten children -- an answer, perhaps a mother's prayer for ten children? That gift of \$48 will give ten people Water for Life. \$144 will give 30 people.
