Week 7: WFL Mission Special #2

James & Betty Robison

James: Welcome to *LIFE Today*. I'm James Robison. Betty and I are thrilled to share something with you that is a miracle. Every time we talk about Jesus and what He does, it's a miracle. I know you've been praying for a miracle in this nation to see us correct our very foolish and dangerous course. We know we can't trust men to do it. We trust God to use men and women to do it, to use vessels yielded to Him. We pray as church leaders that we can speak transforming truth into people's lives that changes their heart and their mind. And we're believing – we're believing in this year '17 that we're going to see some miracle correction. The Bible calls it repentance.

Betty: And it is even more important now, James that we don't stop praying. We continue to pray more fervently and be involved because this is our country that we're talking about and it's a place we live and we're affected by the things that affect us from the government or whatever. We've got to stay involved, especially in prayer.

James: Well, we reap the results of the decisions we make. Any time we as a people cast aside, put down, overlook, deny, change or alter God's truth we suffer the consequences, and they're not good. We've been suffering those consequences. Now many people, even who don't claim to be a Christian, they've said, "We got things changed."

Some people say, "We've got to drain the swamp."

Somebody else said to me the other day, "It's actually a cesspool."

In other words, everything we do outside the will of God is not fruitful, it's rotten. You can turn the fruitful fields over the Lord to the beasts and the birds of prey and the beasts of the field and they can trample everything, devour it like the locusts in Joel; came in and devoured all the fruitfulness of the land. But look what God said. Think about this. This is from God to people who have seen their rotten decisions cost them everything.

He says, "If you'll rend your heart not your garments..." Don't just play religious stuff but if you'll really pray.

By the way, I think a lot of Christians, a lot of people, evangelicals were the largest identifiable block in this last election and 52% of all Catholics made a decision to say we need to make some correction that we're hoping for but our hope is in the Lord. And even those of you who may not have voted for what you see, you may have stood against it, but listen. God is for all of us. God is for you. God cares about your concerns. Everyone that feels overlooked by Uncle Sam or overlooked by the establishment or the leaders or the elite or the political – or even the church, God is not overlooking you. God is reaching out to you.

Here's what I want you to hear. If we yield our lives to God and we lose our life in His kingdom purpose, Jesus said you will find life, abundant life. Not necessarily abundance in life, but abundance of life even without stuff. "I want to give you joy."

But He says He will make up for the years the locusts have eaten. You get your heart right and I'm going to bless you with the former and latter rain. You're going to again grow grain. You're going to grow vineyards. In other words, you're going to see your needs met, you're going to become successful. That's what God wants for us.

So Betty, we can rejoice that God have given us a chance to see a miracle awakening come, to see us actually have changed hearts and minds. Here's what I know. When we ask God to use us to be an answer to people's prayers and to be a miracle He answers that prayer.

Betty, one of the greatest joys our viewers tell us, and we know this personally, that they experience is the experience of being an answer to someone's prayer and being the miracle they hope for.

Now think about this. For years we have been giving cups of water by giving wells of water in areas where they don't have clean water; 5,000 freshwater wells drilled. Right now we're committed at this very moment to drill 188 areas where there are wells of such critical need.

Betty, we've got another miracle! For years we've had areas where the terrain did not allow us to go in with the well drilling equipment – couldn't get it in and these people needed water. Someone invented a filter system that is just like dialysis for kidneys and it gives people water basically in a simple filtration system that can take the filthiest, most contaminated, disease-ridden, bacteria-ridden water and give you fresh, perfect clean water and we can deliver these to families.

Betty, for \$100 we can give three families one of these water filtration systems in the areas where you can't get in and we're asking God while we drill those 188 wells, \$4800 apiece, we're asking God to let us give 5,000 of these filter systems; three of them for \$100. I think we're going to see a miracle.

Betty: It's awesome! What a way to be able to get to the people that we can't get in to drill water wells, James. I'm so excited about this. I think the people, you that have helped us so many times in drilling the wells will be excited about this too because we can expand even further to reach out and save the lives of so many people.

James: This is a miracle. This is the simple miracle to where somebody with scientific knowledge has developed a filter system nothing short of miraculous! I want you to watch it work right there on the field. Watch!

On the mission field

Ralph: For several years now we have been drilling 500 plus wells a year, bringing clean water to villages all over the world.

But throughout our travels we have located places, up in the mountain areas especially, where they cannot get well-drilling rigs, to those locations. And we just hear story after story from mothers who their child gets deathly ill and many of them even die, simply from drinking contaminated water. The sources they get this water from are just like mud puddles. It's full of germs and full of bacteria and worms.

We've prayed about what can we do to bring clean water to those places where we can't drill a well. And we have decided to make available these water filtration systems. What it is, it's a bucket and a hose. The hose connects to a filter and this filter will drop into what's called the clean water bucket and in about 30 minutes to 45 minutes they can actually have beautiful, clean water.

So where we can't get a rig into to drill, we can take one of these filtration systems and we can provide water for a family. They can keep it in their home and we can pass these out around the village. But this is something that we've been blessed to offer to the families that are kind of forgotten up in the mountain areas that we can't even get a vehicle sometimes, but especially a drilling rig.

So, we feel very blessed to have these and we just pray that they're going to bring change and hope to a lot of people up in the mountain areas.

James: Let me just tell you something. I want to tell you. You don't have to wonder if that water is clean when our missionaries are standing there and drinking it in front of you because they know what that water is like before that filter system. And when I used one of them up here they said, "This is so simple!" It doesn't have to have any power source. It's just gravity fed down through the filter into a clean container or into one cup or glass or container after the other. We can take this – think about this – to 5,000 families. Betty, in those families, a lot of times, there can be anywhere from three to six or seven kids. So you talk about a miracle! This is like walking in with a miracle.

But hey! Don't overlook the fact we're committed in areas that we can get in that the situation is so grave that our missionaries said you've got to tell the people we've got 188 sites now and we have to start right now to drill those 188 wells, \$4800 apiece. We need a miracle response today.

Betty, with all my heart I'm just believing God is going to grant it. If people cannot do the \$4800 or the \$1200 toward it and pray others join or half that amount for the well, \$2400, I know many give \$48 to give 10 people water. But when you say to people we can give three families a filtration system that will give them clean water regardless of what it's like when they get it and put it into the system and it's \$100 to give three families? I think people's hearts are going to leap to do it.

Betty: Absolutely! My heart leaps within me because as a mother I can imagine that mother having this tool in which she can purify the water for her babies, for her children! Maybe she's already seen some die from the diseased water and having to take them down to where all that water is, that diseased water, not having to come back and then watch them drink that water knowing what it will do to them, possibly kill them, and this is such a difference. I can just see smiles coming on the faces of mothers, James.

James: I want you to... I'm watching you on the monitor there. I love to watch you. You know that. Just think. I've watched this smile. You and I will soon be married 54 years but we went together four years so going on 60 years I've been watching that smile. You know what? It's a smile like that that goes on a mother if they haven't lost a child. Most of them have a child that's ill because of the water and they're seeing a very diseased emaciated little child. And they keep going back to the same source.

You say, "Why would a mother do that?" Because they can't live many days without water and it is the only source. You and I are the answer. We are – together!

Betty and I joyfully, from the time we started drilling water wells, we said, "God, we want to drill a well."

And then the missionaries came and said, "We need to do this twice a year."

So we said, “God, let us drill another well.” I’m going to tell you, from the time we made that commitment to do what was a stretch, we have watched God bless indescribably. He says that He makes it possible for those who joy in giving to be able to give even exceedingly, abundant what they ever even thought about because if it’s in your heart to give then you have the ability to give, we can’t give what God doesn’t provide.

Father, I pray that right now we will have many people say, “I can’t give a well but I can give three of those filter systems. I can step out and give \$100. Or I can give \$48 for a well we drill and give 10 people water.” Lord, I pray you’ll speak to their heart and they’ll make a commitment. I want your love to flow through me in a stream of expression and of giving. Giving not just monetary support but water, life, a future; in Jesus’ name.

There is right there the website number; you can go there. Or you can dial that number that’s always there as a prayer line and say, “I want to make a gift.” I pray you’ll do it. I pray that this day you will make the greatest gift of love and life you possibly can.

I want you to listen to this child. I want you to see what they’re saying and then I want you to be the solution to the question. I want you to provide a better answer, the real answer. Watch. Pray. But obey what the Spirit impresses you to do.

Child’s voice: I take my mother’s hand and I walk with her for miles to find water to drink. And I ask, “Why, Momma?”

I watch as she dips her cup into the filthy water that we share with the dirty animals and again I ask, “Why, Momma?”

I watch as my brothers and sisters, one by one become ill after drinking our water and still I ask, “Why, Momma?”

I look upon my brother’s grave and watch my mother cry and I’m afraid to ask, “Am I next, Momma?”

Announcer: Our children look to us to make sense of what they see. Far too many mothers around the world must carry the burden of knowing they have no other option than to give contaminated water to those most precious to them, their own children.

They must daily live with the knowledge that by their own hands they may cause their children to grow ill and possibly die. It is not a matter of *if* but *when*. For many of us who look upon this

dilemma we must also ask ourselves, when will we help stop this cycle of illness and death? If not now, then when?

In the studio

James: Father, let it be now! Please!

Would you move to your iPad, your laptop, your computer, whatever, the website you see. These are places where they’ve already found it. The missionaries said this is critical. Betty: Absolutely, James! I’m reminded of that song, “This little light of mine, I’m going to let it shine.” This is reaching out in darkness and being a light to someone that we can’t get the water well systems to dig there to them but we can be a light and offer the filter so that they can have another day with their children, maybe a future with their children. Some of you have made the commitment Betty and I have and that’s to drill a well every time we have the emphasis when the missionaries say we’ve got the areas located; and you’ve helped us buy the drilling rigs and replace drilling rigs that have worn out. You just did that last year. We thank you for that. So I know that you want to help.

Here’s the thing. If you can’t give a well, or \$1200 or \$2400 toward the \$4800, you can give \$48 to give 10 people water; by joining with others we drill a well. The filter is designed out of what God designed. And scientific minds developed this. Every time we find something man created

Ralph: We all know what it's like to be hot and thirsty, dry mouth, dry throat, whatever it is. And then to know that feeling of going to a refrigerator and getting good, clean, cold water.

Now just think about how desperate you would have to be to come to a hole like this and say, "Yes, I'm going to try to drink that to make me feel better."

But this is their life, every day just trying to survive drinking this type of water. What do you see here? You see a cup of dirty water. That's what I see, just dirty water.

But what should really alarm us is what we can't see. What we cannot see is the germs and the disease that's contained in this one cup of water. We have heard testimonies from mothers who have lost five children from drinking just polluted, filthy, disease-infested water. One lady cried out and said she doesn't know of a mother who hasn't lost a child to this filthy water. They have no other choice. They have no choice then to drink this germ-infested water.

We have a choice and we can drill a well in this very village. We can drill down and bring clean, beautiful water that will bring life to this village. We can stop this disease. We can stop the deaths. We can stop the burials. We can stop the tears and bring beautiful, clean water to this village who desperately need a touch of God's love.

James: Well, from the depth of my heart I say thank to you, Ralph Done. He is our Mission's Director, goes as Betty and I have done to the ends of the earth.

Betty and I feel like we went into the very pit of hell, many times around the world in warring situations, very dangerous and where we never had a place to stay other than a tent or a grass hut, mud hut, or a shipping container. It's love that sends you.

Ralph is going all over the world meeting with these missionaries. He also provides the oversight because we require everything to be totally accountable and overseen. We never let the foreign governments have our resources or our things or control, we oversee it, and godly missionaries are there on the scene. So when you hear Ralph standing there, knows the situation and realizes two things right now that are miraculous, one we can drill a well and it will give people water the rest of their life.

Those wells cost \$4800. People give \$1200, \$2400, others join we've got a well. Some are able to give \$4800. If you can, please do it. It's critically important because we depend upon those who can do that.

But then, Betty, \$48 or \$144 literally gives 10 people or 30 people water the rest of their life.

But now we've got something else very special. We can give every family their own filter system. It's a simple container with a filter that works like dialysis that's kind of a miracle invention, just gravity flow. They get the dirty water. They put it in the container. It runs out with gravity flow control and they've got clean water. Dirty water, filthy water becomes clean enough anybody can drink it and know that it has no disease, no bacteria in it. So that in itself is like a miracle gift from God.

So would you help us? Can you drill a well or give toward a well? Or could you give \$100 to give three of those filter system? Whatever you can do, we're asking you to make that gift of love right now knowing that you're going to be giving people life.
