Mission Feeding Special

James: I'm James Robison. My wife Betty and I welcome you to this very special program.

You know when you long to see people who face challenges find the answer to their challenge and you think about God, who is love, expressing that love by giving his greatest gift, his own son for a very specific purpose, a miraculous purpose, to give us life. Betty, not only life now and I'm going to elaborate on that in just a moment but eternal life through the Christ, through the gift.

The thing about God's love is it actually gives us what Jesus said he came to give, it gives us the opportunity to have abundant life. Now not necessarily abundance in life but abundant life even when we're facing a challenge. But think about this. Betty and I, we lost our youngest child, our youngest daughter, Robin. You know that. And that is one of the greatest challenges you can face. But the miracle of God's grace is indescribable.

I want to say something to you right here in a very personal way because I don't know what you're going through but I'm going to tell you this with no exaggeration, if Betty and I could deliver to you the miracle to help you deal with a challenge that you face, I promise you we would deliver it.

Recently, I spent quite a bit of time praying with a family that had lost a son, a young son in a situation where it appears it never should have happened. And it really caused them in many ways to despair of life. Not to want to live. After ministry time, which the whole family called miraculous, he expressed it this way, "I felt like God used James and Betty to give us a license to live." And Betty, the joy that filled them was one of the most meaningful, precious, special moments of my life. We were the vessels through which God delivered his miraculous power to heal even the most severe broken heart.

I want you to know this today and I want to say it to you as clearly and as personally as I can. Betty and I support outreaches like St. Jude's. We rejoice over what the Shriner's Hospital does for precious little children. I love to see those little ones saying thanks. But you know many times we will see the children there and they're not able to come back and give a joyous report because they didn't find the cure. But when you see the cure and you see the effect of love it just causes your heart to overflow.

Listen to me please. I want to say to you right now that you can be the greatest miracle some mother, some grandparent, some individual ever longed for -- the perfect miracle! I want you to watch and I don't want you to turn away. God please! I want everyone to look knowing we're the channel to which you flow the necessary miracle. Let me tell you something, it is perfect.

So when you see reality here, what the grim reaper wants to put on precious little ones and their family, and know this, I hold the cure. Not just the hope but the miracle. So you look and know we get to be the channel through which God flows an indescribable miracle. And Betty, we're going to be praying that every person watching will realize we're the hope, we're the vessel, we

provide the miracle. Watch!

On the mission field:

Announcer: I am mother's worst nightmare. I thrive on the pain of children. I do not discriminate and I show no mercy.

Sheila: You look into the eyes of a child who is seriously malnourished and there's just nothing. It is like somebody just turned the light off.

Announcer: You won't see me coming but you will soon hear me in your children's cries.

[Child crying]

Announcer: My touch brings bloated stomachs, thinning hair that changes color, painful skin disorders and tiny bodies so thin and frail they appear as living skeletons.

Sheila: And to see this little helpless one with the skin literally peeling off his arms and his legs was such a horrifying sight.

Announcer: I am slow but sure. My name is malnutrition and my legacy is death.

Sheila: I heard someone on the news one day make a comment about the devastating deaths of children in some countries in Africa. And yet, the reporter suggested that perhaps the mothers there were more accustomed to that because it's very much a part of their life. I've seen with my

own eyes what I knew in my gut -- no mother will ever come accustomed to burying a child.

The thing that really has blown me away the most, all of this is reversible.

In the studio:

James: All right, you saw right there the miracle. Those precious little ones! And you could see how it moved Sheila. Sheila, you're such a blessing getting God's arms of love around those mothers and those precious little ones. But Betty, we've seen the miracle work and it is a miracle of love that our viewers have made possible.

Betty: Absolutely! I can tell you for sure because I know I've experienced it. No mother becomes accustomed to the loss of a child. I don't care if it is more than one -- one is enough! I know the heartbreak of that mother.

But there is a miracle right at the door, right in our hearts coming out of our hearts to help these precious children, these mothers that love their babies so, so much but they are slowly watching them drift away to death. Please join with us and let's make that difference. Be that miracle that they need.

James: We saw so clearly the love of God flowing through people that many we've never met. And when we do meet those of you who help us give life to those who are in such desperate need of the impact of love, and just to have food and nourishment, when you come to us, you may say, "James, one of the greatest joys is providing clean water, helping drill a well." "James, to know

that we fed these little children and given them a future." That's what we do because the thing you need to understand, you know, Betty, when we first went and I can remember this real desperate prayer you prayed. When we went in those early days it was so horrible, and in the midst of a war. We were there in the over 20-year civil war in Angola. We were there when the communist Marxist gunships and helicopters and weapons and their soldiers were there taking over Mozambique. And there was this war and neither side killed us because they couldn't deny we were saving little children. How could they kill the people doing it? So we went through the war but we watched a miracle.

And we saw these children coming when they heard there was food and we would be expecting maybe a thousand and several thousand would show up and we would always run out of food. And we would watch these little kids crawl in the barrels and scrape it. We had to say many times, "Stop!" We were frightened. We were nearly pushed into the fire.

And Betty started praying, God, please let the line to feed them be longer than the line to be fed. And you became the miracle answer to that prayer. And this isn't wishful thinking, Betty. It so turned things around that we got the entire family stabilized to where in one of the areas where they were really pressing in on us, it was frightening, we actually taught them how to refurbish and re-cultivate and clean the Portuguese farms that the Portuguese had built, and to get the water flowing again. And they began in one area, Betty where we were feeding thousands and thousands because 10,000 had died right there, those people began to grow food. And we went back years later and they were feeding 10,000.

And then Betty, we began to get them stable enough that we could start feeding in schools. So we know what the miracle of love flowing through our viewers does to give everybody the

greatest miracle of all, life itself. I'm believing every viewer is going to help us.

Betty: I believe you will too. I believe you're anxious and ready to be part of that miracle that saves the lives of these precious little ones. All they need is food. Join with us and let's do that.

James: We make it very clear that this is not total child care but this is miraculous, lifesaving, life-giving nourishment that changes everything. We can feed three children for the next months for \$30. We can feed five for \$50. We can feed ten for \$100. I always want to say because I think so many have been so blessed, \$1,000 will feed 100 children for the next several months.

Would you right now make up your mind, I'm going to write a check and make it to *LIFE* because that's what I'm giving. But I'm going to call them and tell them I'm mailing it. But would you go and get your bankcard and would you go online and would you dial the number and say, "This is a lifeline today and I'm going to make a gift."

Even now I want you to begin moving in that direction but I want you to pray, God, I want you to show me what to give. And I want this to be a miracle that gives life, hope, and a future. And I believe it will. Thank you so much for being sensitive to God. Pray that everybody watching will help.

>> Sub-Saharan Africa's child mortality is one of the highest in the world. Nearly half of the deaths can be attributed to the effects of malnutrition. [Woman weeping loudly]

Announcer: The pain that comes from losing a child is indescribable. There are simply no words. It is possibly the worst experience one can know in this life. And to realize that your child has died due to malnutrition causes a parent to be riddled with guilt for not being able to provide the necessary food to sustain their child's life. For so many parents, like Margarita, she did all she could for her baby but it simply was not enough.

Open Captions:

>> When my baby girl died, I lost all my strength inside. It's so hard to find food for my children. She was sick one day and died the next. I still have not accepted her passing. She died so quickly.

Announcer: Margarita's grief became almost unbearable when her youngest child she now holds in her arms appeared to have died as well.

Open Captions:

>> Two days ago everyone started crying because they thought my youngest baby had died. Everyone started to mourn, but suddenly she came back! Each day I pray that God will continue to give life to my baby.

Announcer: Just like Margarita has been given a second chance, we now have a chance to be an answer to her prayers.

In the studio:

James: We can imagine -- did you see her when she lost the little baby and she's just patting that little baby that she couldn't know she was even touching her.

O God, I pray with all my heart that every person watching today would say, "Hey! I'm going to be an answer to that mother's heart cry. I'm going to be an answer to her prayer. I'm going to give those children a future." Jesus.

Betty, we've seen our viewers do this. They are a miracle to so many people.

Betty: They really are. I'm sorry for all the tears but as I was watching that mother pat her baby, I remember our 40-year old daughter sitting by her bedside, knowing that she was probably going to leave us soon. And she was in so much pain. She would say, "Mom, will you just rub my legs? It just helps the pain." And I would just pat and rub her legs, and her feet. And I thought, I know what that mother feels like. It is a deep, deep hurt. We don't want these precious mothers to go through this again. They have other children that if we don't get the food to them they will die too.

So please help us. It is urgent that you help us get the food to these precious little ones.

James: I want all of you to know too, we couldn't even -- we couldn't have ever gone back to those tragic places of pain if we didn't know we could be the miracle. You can't go and watch suffering you can't deal with. Here's the thing I know. You need to understand in my journey, I'm trying to get people to come to the table of reason and love.

We don't have a single challenge here in the United States, you don't have any in Canada, Australia, or the United Kingdom that people, created in the image of God, who will love God and ask him for wisdom that we can't sit down and effectively address the challenges.

And right now you're watching, I believe because God got your attention and you can be a part of the miracle God offers. He gave us a miracle of life through the gift of His Son. Not only life now but forever. And then He tells us we're to be a channel through which He flows rivers of life, rivers of love.

And so we're asking you right now, go get your bankcard, use it like a check. I pray you'll make the greatest gift you possibly can because you're giving the greatest gift there is and that's life. And then the missionaries are pointing them to the love and life of God that inspired the love that moved you to give them life and hope.

On the mission field:

Announcer: Right now Angola is experiencing one of the worst droughts in years, destroying crops impacting the lives of nearly two million people. As a result, over 100,000 children under the age of five are suffering with severe malnutrition. One of those children is named Elaina. She is almost two years old but she only weighs 18 pounds. Elaina's mother, Rosalina came to a malnutrition clinic desperate for her daughter to be healed.

Open Captions:

>> I used to give Elaina my milk. She started getting sick when I ran out. Elaina cries when she's hungry but I have nothing to give her. I am very worried that she is still losing weight.

Announcer: Elaina's skin disease can be a fatal symptom of malnutrition. When a child is not

getting enough food the lack of protein results in large painful lesions all over the body.

If treated early enough the skin lesions can be healed but the long-term effects of malnutrition will be with a child for the rest of their lives. The cure for malnutrition is simply food. A daily bowl of food will keep children out of the malnutrition clinics and give them the life they deserve. That is the miracle of mission feeding.

In the studio:

James: I'm telling you, Betty, we know that this is a miracle that never fails. Love never fails. But love also expresses itself freely. When you saw those children holding these bowls, do you know where they came from? Viewers like you who watched our program, *LIFE Today* or some of the mission specials that we did, and you would watch the children coming with a dirty tin can, and then the hot soup would burn their little fingers. Sometimes they would bring a plastic bag and the soup mix would burn right through the bag and fall in the dirt. They would drop down in the dirt and begin scooping up the muddy soup trying to eat it.

And some of you said to us over and over, "Why don't you get them a heat resistant bowl?" The missionaries said we can't afford to buy the bowls. We've just got to feed them. You know what you said? "We'll give them bowls." That's what love does. Love finds an answer. It becomes a miracle.

Many of you right now may say, "James, I'm going to give ten children food. I'm going to make a \$100 gift." You give five children, \$50, we can feed them for the next months. This is the way

our viewers have thought.

Betty, we have seen miracle after miracle. We would walk in, if you had a challenge and we had the cure in our hand, there is nothing that would keep us from getting to you to say here it is. See love never fails. By the way, your love and prayers for us has sustained us with the loss we've experienced. Don't ever doubt that. We're asking you when we can be the perfect miracle together let's do it.

So if you'll simply get a bankcard, use it like a check or write a check, make it to *LIFE* but go online, let us know the gift is coming or you're making it now or dial that number.
