Week 50: Fall Mission Feeding

James and Betty Robison

Mission feeding special #3

JAMES: Well, I'm James Robison. Betty and I welcome you to *LIFE Today*. I want to ask you to do something. We come to you. We really want to be a blessing to you. We want to be a blessing to everybody because God wants to bless everybody. He loves us all so much. But what I'd like you to do because a lot of times you say, okay, you're going to be sharing some things that really help me.

Okay, let me just say this to you. I'm asking you to watch. We're going to be talking to Isak Pretorius in Africa. This is the son of the missionary that we've worked with now for over 30 years before he went to heaven. But the ministry that God's love through people like you established, save with no exaggeration, millions and millions of lives. Please listen to me. What you watch, what you see and how you respond will determine the destiny of hundreds, even thousands, and ultimately, millions of people.

Betty, we went into hell for a heavenly cause. But the point is we saw these children so desperate, and we loved them so much. Boy, we never hesitated to hold the filthiest, the neediest little child, broken heart of a mother. But you began to say, "I want the line to feed these children to always be longer than the line of children needing to be fed." What led you to say that?

BETTY: Like you said, we've been there many, many times and we've been in the situations where we would run out of food. It's just hard to know how much food it would take sometimes. But I would see these precious children stand in line, so orderly and waiting so anxiously to get a little bowl of porridge, something to fill their tummies with. We'd get caught at the end of the line of these precious little ones and we'd run out. What

do you say to them? My heart was broken.

So that's when we came back home, I said, James, I pray, and I still pray this today, that the lines that we see of those precious little ones lined up to get a bowl of soup, that the line that reaches out to them, that's you, that's me, that line is longer than the children's line. And it will always have enough food to give the last person in line. I pray that continuously.

JAMES: And the missionaries have told us you're the greatest miracle they've ever seen. I'm telling you, that you are really something. Because I would talk about how great the missionaries are, and boy, they are. It's the love of God filling them. They take their whole family, so many times and they move from their homeland right into the midst of that suffering to get the arms of God's love around people.

And many times, people say, "I want to go over there and help them." You know what the missionaries will say? "James, please ask them not to come over because we don't have time to train all of them. And we've got to stay here. Would you just please ask the people watching to let us just stay here and do what God sent us here to do?" That's what Betty was praying.

So let me just please, please ask you. Listen to Isak Pretorius but listen for the voice of God. Listen to the heart of God expressed through missionaries like Isak and the hundreds, and right now several thousand trained workers that are on the scene as they help feed the hungry.

We're going to talk to Isak in Africa right now. Father, bless this time together. Isak, it is amazing how COVID has kept people from doing what they normally do, and how it has increased the problem there all over Africa, increased the need, the disease, the death. And I'm just asking you to just share your heart with us because we need to know what you are actually seeing right now so our viewers can catch a vision of what you're experiencing and become the miraculous answer to the challenge. Isak?

ISAK: Well, James, the conditions in South Sudan are just devastating at the moment. We've seen the worst floods in recorded history in that nation destroying the lives of so many; close to a million people that are being displaced. No ability to grow their own food. Destroying all of their harvest. Many of them losing their homes.

Those floods have destroyed 16 of our malnutrition clinics. Malnutrition clinics that you know very well are literally the lifeline to tens of thousands of children. What's this is resulting in is that the plight of the mother in South Sudan has worsened to the highest levels, James. Mothers literally just trying with everything inside of them, doing everything they can to save their children's lives. But in somewhat of a hopeless situation if we are not able to respond and to help them.

JAMES: Isak, I wish Betty and I were right there with you. Boy, we love you, and all those mission workers. What you said about the horrible effects in South Sudan, most precious people pushed out because of rotten religion and rotten government oversight. Beautiful people, like Franklin Graham said, more like New Testament Christians than any people.

But while we're looking at that situation there's another crisis that is the exact opposite of flooding in areas like Angola. Tell us about that.

ISAK: Yes, James. In Angola, we're seeing the exact opposite of South Sudan. We're seeing the effects of multiple years of drought. This last drought being absolutely devastating because now there is no harvest. In areas where we have been able to help families, and you know how important those crops are, James, because you've been a part of us helping those families to grow their own crops, to feed themselves, to feed their community but that's all gone now. There is no ability because there is no rain. And without rain we cannot grow crops.

But what that also means is that we're seeing malnutrition clinics fuller than we've ever

seen them. Many of the beds with two or three children, children on the floor, not enough space to cater to all of those children that are literally now fighting that battle of life and death.

JAMES: Boy, Isak, it tears at my heart because in the very area where the numbers are coming, once they find out you've got this food center, feeding center then people begin to come many more kilometers. They will walk for a day or two to get there. And we've watched us run out of the food. And we've got these kids crawling in the empty barrels scraping to get something. It was desperation what led you to pray for the longer lines to feed them, to get them food. And we taught those people, we got them on their feet, and they cleared and planted a plantation. They began feeding that little very area that was starving, feeding 10,000 hungry people themselves. So we know the importance of those crops.

Now if they're destroyed because of droughts and I mean all of the challenges that have come to you has increased the number and the need beyond comprehension. Share with us, Isak, something that will help people understand how vitally important their support is, please.

ISAK: James, that truly is their reality. People are so desperate for food right now. They're clamoring, they're doing everything they can like those kids climbing in that pot to get that last little bit of that life-sustaining food.

James, the reality is that the malnutrition clinics have been impacted and whether it is from floods in South Sudan or from droughts in Angola, or the pandemic that has overlaid all of that and impacted our continent in the most significant way, we literally, I'm seeing crisis like we've never seen it before. We're seeing more people suffering from malnutrition. We're seeing more people who are literally starving to death. They have absolutely no access to food. More people who are reliant on us because what we're doing each and every day is literally saving lives. The conditions here are truly the worst that I've ever seen, James. And the reality of that is that if we are not able to react, to respond,

to do everything that we can do we will lose more lives than we've ever lost in the past.

JAMES: Boy, Isak, when you talked about the malnutrition clinics now being so full, and those places have been destroyed all over South Sudan, we're being told that we have the crisis in Angola, we see the powerful effect of the malnutrition clinics and we know we need to replace 16 in South Sudan, as an example.

Father, we need a miracle here. We need some people who will step up. Maybe somebody says I'll give a clinic. I don't know what they can do but 24 people could step up and say I'll give a \$1,000, we'll have a clinic restored. Please do it, Lord.

Okay, so you're the key. You're the answer to not only that prayer I just prayed but you're the answer to the prayers of all the missionaries and relief workers. You're actually, think about this, you're actually the answer to the prayers of mothers for their children they love so much. You're the miracle that they're longing for.

You know what we found out? That during the pandemic the crisis intensified. The number of people they had located that needed help and they helped multiplied many times. Isak explained the increase in need right now. So that everybody watching will understand, we need a supernatural New Testament miracle today. Tell us what's going on. Tell us the extent of it.

ISAK: Yes, James. That's exactly what we need. We literally need a New Testament miracle right now because the crisis that we're seeing is of levels that I have never seen or experienced before. You know in 2019 we assisted 1.1 million people and yet in 2020 we assisted close to 4 million people--and that number just keeps growing. If we're not able to respond, if we're not able to continue to reach those people to meet their needs, we're going to see more children suffering from malnutrition, we're going to see more children dying, we're going to see more people who are literally facing starvation because they have no access to any food at all. They're trusting us. They're looking to us as a lifeline to express God's heart and to extend his hands.

James, I know that you know the level of this crisis. You've told me many times. You wish that every viewer would respond, would do something, would do what they can do. That literally is the prayer we need answered right now. That is the miracle we need. Because if every viewer will respond, if every viewer will do what they can do, give the gift that they can give today, we will be able to meet the needs of the people here in Africa that are desperately relying on us. We will be able to save those lives. We can save those lives. But we cannot do it unless people respond. Unless every viewer gives the very best gift that they can give.

James, we cannot do it without you. That's why I'm asking you from the bottom of my heart, please do whatever you can do so we can save the lives that are relying on us.

JAMES: Isak, when you know that together we've witnessed saving over 15, recent reports over 17 million lives together and you know what the workers do. But you know it couldn't happen without the viewers of *LIFE Today* and people who are watching. Betty, they really are the miracle that mothers are praying for that every hungry child needs. And it's a joy to be a miracle, isn't it?

BETTY: It really is. I hope you'll continue. You've probably helped us before feeding the children, maybe it's your first time, but what an opportunity and gesture of love to reach out to these children. They need the food desperately. These mothers want to care for their children, but they have no resources now. So please join with us and let's all together, it takes like James said, it takes all of us to reach out and to fulfill the needs of these children.

JAMES: Well, Isak made it clear that the extremity of the crisis right now is almost beyond description. It is going to take a miracle. God, I'm asking you for it and you use people to deliver miracles. They're the vessels through which you flow freely your love, your compassion, in Jesus' name.

If we could see that miracle today of everyone watching who could do anything. Listen. Do not say it's too little. Remember, \$30 enables us to feed three for the next months. Not total childcare, not housing, but you can see what happens when you give these people a chance at life. They're not looking for luxury, they're looking for *life*. Those mothers love those children. They're the greatest joy they have. They have no other entertainment. They don't live with all the things we're exposed to. That's why loving them has such a beautiful, literal transformative effect that changes everything! Remember once we get them stabilized, we start feeding them at school to get them to go to school.

Please! Be the miracle right now. Go online, dial that number there; it is a crisis line right now. It is a lifeline, always a prayer line--right now it's a lifeline! Would you go take your bankcard or call and say, I'm writing a check, I'm making it to *LIFE*. I'm giving life. And tell us what you're putting in the mail.
