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Week 24: Spring Mission Feeding: Last week

James and Betty Robison

Mission special #2

JAMES: I know I say this a lot, but I wish we could just be right there in the room with you. One of the things we've noticed by not having an audience, it's like I just feel like I'm trying to move in there with you.

By the way, I'm James, this is Betty; this is *Life Today*. We want *Life Today* to, in some way, impact and bless your life today. We're going to show you the joy of blessing someone's life today -- people you may have never even thought of, the least noticed, and "the least of these" Jesus called them -- and the joy of doing it. Betty, these people that we tell them, you don't know how amazing you are. We're going to show them some amazing people who love people. But people like you, and maybe you've never joined this move of God through people but the people out here are the ones that make these amazing people amazing! In other words, they enable them to do what God gifted them to do and called them to do. And you become the one that puts the oil in their lantern. Aren't these awesome people?

BETTY: Absolutely! And I think we have gotten to know each other better. We've been kind of shut in with COVID, the virus, and everything, and people are tuning in more. I think we kind of long for that relationship. So I feel like we do know you better and I hope you know us better and know that we care about you and we so appreciate how you join with us to help others.

JAMES: Well, you know we've been doing missions now for 30 years for many people. And many of you watching us, you didn't see the crusade evangelist James Robison for more than 30 years crusading in stadiums and coliseums. And then, in the midst of all these blessings, God spoke to me so clearly, "Greatest in my kingdom are servants. And James, I know I've gifted you to speak, I know what I do through you, but I want you to become a servant to all. And I want

you to see the overlooked.” Because see, I was overlooked. I was given away by my mother who was raped and conceived me, and the doctor wouldn't abort me, with an ad in the paper. And then she came and took me from that stable home when I was five and I moved into total poverty and misery. So I know what it is to feel overlooked. I moved so much that I was never picked to play on a team. So I know what that feels like.

So when God said, "I want you to notice the overlooked," I had no idea. Because I was asked to go to a nationwide crusade in South Africa at the height of apartheid. And boy, did I go, and did I preach. I watched some things shift over there, but I never dreamed God would let me see “the least of these” up close and personal. And everything changed.

I want you to just jump back 30 years and I want you to watch what happened. But then I want you to hear very, very clearly how it continued amazingly beyond anything you could have ever imagined. Watch!

JAMES: Friend, that's why you're here! So you can come to God and give him your life tonight. Would you do it? The only way to God is through Jesus.

ANNOUNCER: *It was the 1980s, and James was right where God had called him.*

JAMES: Would you come and say I'm going to leave here and let God be first in my life? I hope you will. Let's bow our heads together.

ANNOUNCER: *Preaching the gospel so that lives could be changed forever, but God had plans that would transform James' life when he and Betty met another evangelist, a South African named Peter Pretorius. Peter showed them the immense suffering people in Mozambique were going through because of the Civil War.*

PETER: You see the thinness of his hair and the color of his hair? That's a sure sign that he's

suffering much from malnutrition.

ANNOUNCER: *James knew he would never stop ministering the Word of God to the poor in spirit, but now he would do everything he could to help those who are physically perishing. Thus, Mission Feeding was birthed between James and Peter. And in time, as faithful supporters began to help feeding efforts expanded into war-torn Angola. The challenge that lay ahead for the Mission Feeding program was trying to keep up with the need in crisis areas where food shortages were critical. Children under the age of five were dying at an alarming rate due to the ravages of a silent killer known as malnutrition.*

JAMES: I have never seen so many children buried in one small place -- more than a thousand bodies here around me right now. And I'm praying, dear God, please, please stop this! I just kneeled right here and there is a fruit jar. In there is the little child's picture in that jar -- somebody's baby! Dear God! Help us to save these children.

ANNOUNCER: *By the grace of God and with the support of faithful partners of LIFE Outreach International, food factories were built in Mozambique and Angola and began turning out a vitamin-enriched soup mix. A fleet of trucks now delivers the processed food mix to remote villages. This has allowed the Mission Feeding program to expand into other areas including South Africa and South Sudan.*

Currently, over 350,000 children receive a daily bowl of this soup mix through both the school feeding and crisis feeding programs. This bowl of food not only has helped stopped the death cycle in hundreds of villages, but it provides an incentive for the children to remain in school.

JAMES: They want a teacher. They want to go to school. They walk a long way. They're trying to learn. I don't know anyone that would look in these faces and not say, well, let me help those children that obviously want a future.

ANNOUNCER: *The Mission Feeding program that started over 30 years ago helping families in war-torn villages has literally saved over 18 million lives according to government sources.*

The challenge now is to maintain the partnership, which will allow us to continue turning out the soup mix for the school feeding program and for meeting crises like the prolonged drought in Angola and the devastating floods in South Sudan.

Together we can ensure that lives will be saved, and the children will have the opportunity to fulfill their God-given potential.

JAMES: Did you hear, now think about this, did you hear the number of how many people like you, and many of you have been so faithful in just reaching out and saying, "I'm going to feed that hungry child. I'm going to do that. I'm going to weep with those who weep, grandparents, parents, family." You reached out -- 18 million, Betty. This isn't something we went out and said. This is what the nations, all the different nations of the world where this is what their authorities report to the missionaries. In other words, this is what love did.

Now here we are winning hundreds of thousands of people to Christ and people wondered, James, when you're moving a whole city, Billy Graham used to say you'd turn out a population of a town, James. You said you don't spend a lot of money to get a crowd; you get people bringing people to Christ. Well, there is no question about it. So we saved millions here. But do you realize 18 million children and their families' lives were saved just in those areas? And we've had more people in those same areas come to Christ in crusades because they've seen love. They didn't just hear love talked about, they saw it demonstrated. They saw the living Jesus who died for us, living through the missionaries. But they were able to be there. Think about this, the missionaries were able to be there because the viewers of *Life Today* kept them there.

Did you know that we had to sell things, this studio laid on the ground, tilled up concrete, laying there for three years where we don't even have a studio but we're talking to you from a little old makeshift deal because I've been on television now over 50 years? But we were doing the preaching and crusades but then I started talking to you, would you love people? We didn't

know! The missionaries we helped for three years came over here and prayed this studio up. We were focusing everything we had on saving the least of these.

Did you know that we went from maybe having a million, maybe two million people saved in a year, at the most, to having seven million or more come to Christ? Not just hungry children saved, people coming to Christ because of what you did.

I want you to listen please to the heart of God. You saw me and Betty and Peter with all these hungry children, and 18 million lives saved because you helped us. Betty, they didn't just look in, they got involved. They said let's put God's arms around the least of these.

But I want you to listen because Peter Pretorius went on to be with the Lord more than two years ago. Listen to his son. Listen to him. Listen to God. Because I'm telling you, you are the miracle somebody's heart longs for. You are the answer to a mother's prayers. You are the answer to many prayers. Watch!

ANNOUNCER: *There was something missing in the Angolan village our team recently visited. It was the laughter and excitement of the children. The worried expressions on these mothers' faces confirmed what we had all been told. This area is in the throes of a food crisis.*

Maria has fought these battles before struggling to feed her family. But now, once again, she finds herself trying to keep her grandchild Mabina alive during this crisis.

ISAK: You can see by just looking at this child how malnourished the grandchild is. Yet, this grandchild is so fortunate to have this angel of a grandmother. A woman who knows what it is to suffer -- to suffer, to fight, but to persevere, to never give up. She explained that she's also lost her ability to feed herself or her grandchild; lost because of the drought here. Not because she didn't make an effort. Not because she didn't work hard. She's done everything she can do.

The question is: Have we done everything we can do? Are we prepared to fight as -- as hard as she fights? Will we give what she's given? Will we give up what she's given up? Or will we do the thing she didn't do, and that is turn a blind eye and say it's too much. Say, I can't do it. I know I can't and I know that I won't. And I'm asking you to have the same answer today; to say I can't, I won't turn a blind eye. I won't try and pretend that I haven't heard this story. Instead, I'll do all that I can do.

JAMES: Betty, he's weeping because he felt the burden of mothers and families. And he said, "I'm not leaving." He's not! He and his wife Terry are just so committed. Our viewers can be the answer to the heart cry of every parent, every grandparent, and every family member. They can be a miracle. And we have watched them become the miracle that will keep those children alive and keep those feeding lines where they have food and we never run out.

BETTY: You know, James, the many years that we've been involved with missions with Peter Pretorius, and his son, and Ann, and all of them over there working so hard, I've watched these different situations that they show us of the need there of food, water, whatever it is, James.

And you say, you ought to be used to it by now. How can you be so compassionate about it still? Because there are still those that need our help. I see the little ones and I think, God, they need some food. They're going to die without it. And we must help them. I ask God, never let my heart get used to seeing those situations. Always bring my heart fresh, updated on what's going on, James, and never let me be compelled to just turn away because I've seen it so many times. Because they're still there, they still need help.

JAMES: You know the amazing thing, and I said you are, in my opinion, just like the missionaries, you are amazing people. You know when you watch *Life Today* we're going to try to pour God's life all over you with incredible stories of miracles of God that will inspire you and encourage you and bless you and take you deeper into the Word and the Word of God more into

But when she only has a little bit of food, she makes sure that she gives it to all three of her children, and many nights this mom goes to bed with nothing -- nothing in her stomach! Just a prayer on her lips, "Lord, will you send me some help?"

>> I am very worried about my children because I know their bodies are not healthy. I know

they're not getting enough food.

SHEILA: Maybe you think, well, how can we change her life? It's really easy -- through mission feeding. Can you imagine the burden that it would take off this mom knowing that her kids get one good meal every single day? It's not a lot to ask.

ISAK: As we've traveled around these communities in southern Angola, family after family has told us how they're experiencing the worst drought they've ever seen. There is nothing to sustain these families unless we're able to help them. That's the reality in these parts of southern Africa right now.
