Week 39: Christmas Shoes & Smiles; Last Day

Mission Special #1

Studio discussion:

JAMES: Let me just tell you, you're about to get blessed. Betty, I am so thrilled. This is -- I'm James Robison. Betty, my wife and I are just thrilled that one day, one of our friends, Jeff Lucas, basically, kind of ran in and said, "Hey! I can get these for just over \$3. You know, you know how expensive this kind of shoe is. We can give these to all the kids in Africa if we can just get the people to help us. We can put shoes on their little feet!" I thought, and man, I don't pay a lot of attention to their feet. I'm so busy trying to feed them and comfort them and help them and love them and clothe them. That's amazing.

Do you know what we got to noticing on the next couple of trips we went? How cut up, how mangled, how damaged, how disease had gotten in their bodies through their feet. I thought, we can do this. We pay \$3.60 for what people pay \$30 and \$40 for.

God, thank you. You're a miracle worker.

We are doing something that's been one of the greatest joys of my life. I want you to look, and you're going to see that whatever you do, don't you miss the end of this program when you see this little girl. Just look at her. She didn't want anybody to look at her.

Now, you stay till the end and don't miss this. I want you to see what the love of God, flowing through people just like you, not just one of you, but all of us together, I want you to look at what the love of God does.

Betty, could you believe when we found out about being able to give shoes to little children, we never had examined or studied their feet. But we found out so many diseases come in through

their feet, and ultimately, get to their brain, or to their intestines, or vital organs and damages or takes their lives. Hasn't this been a thrill?

BETTY: It really has. And as a mother, or grandmother, I love being able to do something like this. That's a real gift to them. They love it. They get so excited. You put shoes on their feet, it's like a Christmas present to them. It is. So thank you so much if you've already done this. But we're going to thank you in advance if you're going to join with us here soon and help us do some more, putting shoes on the feet of these precious children.

JAMES: Well, you know, we've seen a lot of broken hearts here in Texas with the horrible flood; the damage, the lives taken. Only the comfort of God and the peace of God can get people through it. For all of you who prayed for us here in Texas, and all of you who've reached out in some way, put God's comforting arms around those who are so heartbroken, thank you so much! Thank you for your prayers.

I want you to know that together we have worked such deep miracles all over the Third World for the last 20 years or so. And doing the shoes now for, I think, 17 or 18 years. It's just an amazing thing. I want you to listen to John Yeatts, our missions director. He's with our son, Randy, there. They're talking to this tremendous host of young people where we started when they were dying of starvation, and we got them healthy, got them into schools, started feeding them at the schools. Now then, it's just it's like a miracle. Listen to John Yeatts. He's expressing the love of God that pours through you who watch this program and people around the world who just want to extend God's loving arms and do it so effectively. Listen to John.

Transition roll-in:

JOHN: Thank you for having us today. My name is John with *Life Outreach International*. When we came in today, you said we are welcome and God bless you. So we say thank you and may God bless you. We are so glad to be with you today. We're so glad that the Mission Feeding program is working here in your school, and we are so glad that we've been able to

bring shoes today to bless many of you with the new Christmas shoes. Today is a great celebration!

As you know, for years now we've been giving hundreds of thousands of pairs away. But there's still a great need and we want to be a part of just sharing a little bit of joy and a little bit of Christmas love with children around the world. It's going to change the way they walk. It's going to help with infections on their feet. We've seen so many children as we've come through. Their feet are infected. Their toes are infected. They've got cuts on their ankles. And so, we need your help. It takes just a small amount to help with each child.

And remember, it's not just shoes that we give at Christmas time, it's also the smiles. So, around the world, kids that are in need of cleft palate surgeries or kids that are in need of shoes will be able to have a little extra something of joy this Christmas because of your giving. So, whatever you can give, maybe it's small, maybe it's great, but whatever you can do, would you please help us give Christmas shoes just as a simple way of reminding children that God sees them and that God loves them.

Studio appeal:

JAMES: You know, it's no exaggeration, Betty, how much genuine love of God flows through me toward those children, and through you. There's just no way you can look at the least of these, the overlooked, the too often forgotten, and look at them and see what happens when they know that love noticed them. Somebody with love. And then if you can actually do something that they know benefits them in some way, Betty, it just changed that whole area there. I mean, we've listened to these beautiful children, and as they've even grown older and then their families just singing praises to God. And even the smallest of children, after we've gotten them stabilized and gotten them, basically, in the school, which oftentimes, the schools are connected with churches or mission outreaches. And just to see how happy they are. Isn't it beautiful?

BETTY: It's beautiful! What better way to celebrate Christmas than to offer shoes for their feet? Probably most of them have never had shoes, and they're just thrilled over it. And then, those that have never been able to smile, that really touches my heart. I think this year they'll be able to smile. Thank you, Jesus! And thank you for caring and sharing the gifts that God has given you, the way he has blessed you to be able to bless others.

JAMES: You know the shoes are \$3.60. How in the world could you buy what is so obviously a very expensive shoe to people who are buying them all over the world? And yet, we're getting these and we're so grateful for the man who saw the vision and worked with people to be able to make them, and for us to be able to do them now for nearly 20 years. Do you realize that \$36 will give ten children shoes? I don't think there's a person watching who couldn't give those shoes. Could you give ten children a pair of shoes? I know you can. And we can give 20 children, shoes for \$72. There's a level, Betty, which everyone watching can help. And, you know, we not only give shoes, we give smiles. The cleft palate surgery or facial surgery is \$500 because of the doctors basically giving all of their skill. But that's what it costs to do it. Before this show is over, you're going to see something that costs a whole lot more than that, and I'm just so grateful, God, for the way you work through your people.

Would you ask God what he wants you to do? Could you give 10 or 20 pairs of shoes? Could you give \$1,000 or maybe several thousand to offer miracles? Thank you so much. Don't you miss the very last part of this program when you're going to see what I think is as beautiful miracle of love as I've ever seen.

Transition roll-in:

JAMES: Betty, all these people have wondered why we're here. How are you? And we have told them through translators that we're here because we love them and because we want to give them a better life. We came in the name of the Lord Jesus, but we didn't just come to talk about God's love; we came to share it and demonstrate it.

I'm kneeling here in Central America by a contaminated water source, and we love to give water wells. But we found out something else. Because of contaminated water, and

even contamination and problems in the soil, children get little cuts in their feet, and they pick up hookworms. And as I understand it that ultimately gets into their intestines, and it is a horrible sickness. But it is a disease that not only brings incredible pain and discomfort, but in so many instances, death.

BETTY: I'm standing here with these children and they're just a small example of children all over the world. They deserve to be cared for. We have an opportunity to do that right now, to put some shoes on their feet, to give them a chance in life.

I ask you to help us do that. It is a simple request but a very urgent and important one. Please join with us. You'll get such great joy out of it. I know you will. God bless you and thank you.

JAMES: Betty, we spent 15 years just in that area working with shoes, but we spent well over 20 to 25 years working with third-world nations and the poor, and going into the toughest places. But I wanted you to see what love does. Love goes so far beyond what you see. When we poured God's love out on the schools, and many of those schools are in churches, all of these young people became witnesses for Jesus.

I want to ask every one of you who are watching right now to make the greatest gift you can to help us share shoes and smiles. Would you do that? Could you make a \$36 gift and give ten shoes or \$72 and give 20 pairs of shoes – 10 pairs, 20 pairs? Could you give \$500 to provide a facial surgery? Could you give more than that? Just ask God. Transition roll-in: [Victorina update]

JOHN: So we are here in Angola on the way to a village where Victorina has had a life transformation through Christmas Smiles. We're talking about a beautiful little girl who was born with such a tragic cleft palate, one of the worst I'd ever seen, that's been a two-year endeavor that has been with many ups and downs. She was so malnourished. She had wounds on her body that were so infected. She literally spent three months in the hospital before she could have her surgery.

ASHTON: I just remember thinking, Lord, if this is your will, you have to make it happen because there were so many barriers. God was just faithful, and I'm excited to see how she looks today.

JOHN: The first time I saw Victorina, I saw her off in the distance on this huge granite boulder with her and two women pounding out what little bit of cornmeal that they had to make a meal. When I got up here my heart just sank for her. We left, we went back to the village that night where we were camping, and after a long exchange of the kids it was time to go to bed, and Ashton gets up and she walks over and she put her hands on Victorina's cheeks. Ashton was trying to lovingly tell her how beautiful she was.

Victorina ran off crying, devastated. Why? Because she wanted to dwell in the shadow. She wanted to be hidden. She didn't want to be seen. She was ashamed. She was literally in a prison of despair that so broke Ashton's heart that she spent the rest of the night crying in our tent. She asked me, she said, "Dad, isn't there anything we can do for Victorina?"

It began a journey that took hundreds of people, hundreds of hours, and multiple trips to make happen. And now, it has been a day of celebration. It has been a day of miracles. It has been a day of wonder and laughter. Here's a little girl who just two years ago had no friends. And as I'm watching her today in class, she's raising her hand and answering the questions of the teacher in her multiplication. She goes along and she introduces each one of her friends to me by name, playing their dance game or kicking the soccer ball.

Victorina has moved from a prison to an open land of possibilities simply through your generosity and your kindness and your compassion through *Christmas Shoes and Smiles*.

Victorina is an example of thousands of children around the world that we can help this year with a simple surgery. There are so many ways that we can bring smiles to families' lives through giving through Christmas Smiles.

JAMES: I wish Victorina, I could be there and just hold your little face and kiss your pretty little cheeks. I wish I could hug every single person that saw where a miracle is needed, and know the \$500 surgical gift that gives so many a smile was not going to work for her. It was going to take thousands of dollars. You say, well, James, how in the world does that happen? Well, somebody like you, when they pray they hear God say, send two smiles, send a thousand. And then maybe somebody hears, send \$5000. Or maybe you even hear God say more than that. We don't even know how many surgeries are being done by the money that goes past what we ask for in an area, because someone like you became the miracle. You became the avenue for an indescribable miracle.

Betty, I'm praying for all of our viewers to see that precious little face, and to know that we love them when they're scarred or their bodies are torn, or they're hungry. We try to meet the need,

and the need can only be met by love. Not just man's love, but God's love through us as individuals. We can flow the life, the love, and the truth of God like a river through our ability to release what he's entrusted to our watchcare for him to use to accomplish supernatural, eternal miracles.

Would you right now prayerfully go and get your bank card and use it like a check? Maybe this would be the greatest gift you ever made. By the way, if you give someone a smile, if you made a \$500 gift and gave a smile, that'd be the biggest miracle they thought they'd ever see, and their family. But just whatever God says. If you want to write a check, make it to LIFE, but call us and tell us you're putting it in the mail. We want to give 150,000 children shoes and yes, smiles. I promise you, that smile if they just get shoes, they'll smile when they see their friends with shoes. Let's put a lot of smiles on people's faces. Some of them like Victorina's.

ANNOUNCER: *For many of the children, it was their very first pair. A simple gift, but one that means protection, dignity, and hope.*

It is very important to understand, to see the number of children who walk around barefoot in contaminated places with glass and rocks where they can hurt their feet. So it's powerful to see them put on shoes for the first time. It's moving to see their smiles for such a significant act of kindness. A very special thank you to all the people of Life Outreach, and to everyone who is supporting Life Outreach for making this a reality.

ISAK: I've got to tell you what a happy day this is for me. I'm here with kids who've all received shoes today because someone like you was generous enough to say, I'll give \$72.
