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Week 44: Mission: Rescue Life, Last day

Mission Special #2

Studio discussion:

JAMES: Well, I want to welcome you to *Life Today*. I'm James Robison. My wife, Betty and I are really today, heavily-burdened for the most precious people on the planet, and that's children. I can't tell you how much I long for you to hear God putting on your heart his concern for the overlooked, for the abused and the used. When you talk about being used, to imagine people using children for sexual exploitation, to use them for money for years as little trafficked girls and boys, I just can't even imagine that. I can't understand how a person can be sexually attracted to a child. I don't even understand that at all. But the Lord knows I just can't take thinking about people taking little children, Betty and using them for money, and to sell them as sexual slaves to people who will pay tremendous amounts of money to somehow have a sexual predation relationship with them.

BETTY: What we're talking about today is very hard. It's heartbreaking and very hard to even think about. We don't like to dwell on it because it hurts so bad. But just because we try not to think about it doesn't mean it's not happening behind the scenes. These precious little ones are being deceived. They're being told they're going to have a better life. Anything to get them captured by these evil people -- predators. Yes! We need to help them. They're defenseless. They're the innocent.

So I hope you'll pray as you watch and then help us to help these children.

JAMES: For years I've prayed, God, someday I want to talk to the TV audience where every single person watching would say, of course, we're going to pray, of course, we're going to care. But if they can at any level, they would do something to help. And listen to me. We're talking about little children right now all over the world, and we deal with them in so many countries.

Southeast Asia right now, we're trying to intercept the predators at the border and what they're trying to do to little children coming across. Somehow, the predators convinced a child just talking to them that if you get across the border, you're going to be taken care of for the rest of your life. You're going to have a job, you're going to have money, you're going to have everything. You'll have a place to stay. And they come across the border.

What we do is we intercept them. I mean, we've got the most Jesus-filled, God-loving, children-loving, freedom-loving people on the planet who are there intercepting them. But here's what I need you to know. Once we get a child, we then help them rebuild an entire life. It takes \$128 to reach, rescue, and restore one child. That's why we ask people to give \$128 to rescue a child. But we also sometimes need help to build facilities for them. All of that is part of what we're going to talk about today. I'm going to simply say to you -- please, please hear me! If you've ever been hurt to think about how people use a little child, how about how they abuse them, use them for money and exploitation.

What the predators do once they get them in their control, they try to take control by getting them on some kind of drug, where they can control them that way. These people come from childhood, anywhere from 6-8, to 15, 18, in that age group. They will have them there for the next 10 to 25 years and use them for their entire life.

But we, God's people, can intercept and can give them life. This is the greatest miracle that could ever happen to them. You can be that miracle in not just a child's life, but in many. I want you to watch this closely, and I want you to really pray about this. God, how can I help those who've been taken captive to be totally set free and have a new life? Watch closely.

Transition roll-in: [Human Interceptors]

SHOVANA: You asked me why I do what I do. I'm motivated by the Scripture verse in Psalm 82, verse four: Rescue the needy and the afflicted, and deliver them from the hand of the wicked. How do we deliver people who are in the hand of the wicked? It's us. It's God's people.

I'm almost in tears because I know how heart-wrenching it is, because trafficking happens globally and a huge mess in our hands.

This particular country where I work, the borders are open. So these open borders become fertile ground for trafficking to occur. There are many dance bars or singing bars, and at night, it's a front, but at nighttime they turn into prostitution, sex slaves. That's what's happening. And those who can't find work, they are looking for work elsewhere, out of the country, faraway places. That's when the young girls end up as domestic workers and even bonded labor. And many of them end up in sex slave trades.

The most effective means to curtail sex trafficking in this particular country is by becoming human interceptors. So what we do is we have trained team staff members. Their job is to stop the traffic, ask questions. We work very closely with the local authority right then and there. And we contact their guardians, their parents. So parents are thrilled that we have found their kids. So we care for them. We provide shelter, we provide clothing, we provide food. However long it's going to take, they are in our care. That's when we have the opportunity to talk to them about the dangers of trafficking, counsel them, and show them just the love of the Father, and "Somebody cares for you."

My heart is to continue to be the advocate, and our team to continue to be the voice for the voiceless, and bring freedom where it's needed for the glory of God. But we can do so much more. We need your help.

JAMES: You know, that's part of Southern Asia. But, you know, that's one of our partners. These are the most beautiful people. A lot of them are from the countries, other countries around there and come in as missionaries, but many of them, Betty move from here and move overseas. They stay for years. Some of them stay the rest of their life. Their kids grow up there. These are people that had not only the call of God on their life, they have the love of God carrying them. That's what we, as *Life Today* and *Life Today* viewers, you're the greatest miracle

workers, in my opinion, on the planet because in love, you release help, you release an escape route, and a way to life. We not only reach, we rescue, and then we restore. We train them for a life.

But it takes \$128 per child just to start. \$1,280 rescues ten. Please, I want to ask you to really ask God, what can I do? Can I help one or ten?

Father, please let everybody watching know that they really, because of the missionaries, because of people that plant their lives in the midst of that suffering and that terrible bondage and prison that those people are in, those precious little children that spend their life there, that God, the people watching us right now are a perfect source of rescue because of the missionaries. Thank you, God.

I'm just really praying that as you watch what we're sharing with you today, that every person, Betty, and you know, I've prayed this and I will all my life, someday, let every person watching that can do anything, that everybody do something. I know you're praying, but could you reach out and rescue one? Could you give a part of rescuing one?

I want you to watch as we talk about a tremendous need for a facility and a place to take care of more of these desperate-in-this-situation girls. I want you to listen. I want you to watch. I want you to pray. And I want you to follow the Father's lead and his love. Watch closely.

Transition roll-in:

>> Human trafficking, What it means is modern-day slavery where vulnerable people are exploited in two categories. One, labor trafficking, forced labor. And the other is sex trafficking.

>> Traffickers who traditionally would sell guns or drugs, they're now turning to selling children because a gun you can sell once, a drug you can sell once but a child you can sell over and over again.

Open captions: They just tied the hands, both hands like that, and the customer would have sex with that child.

>> Our restoration home is overflowing. This is a problem. And guess what? It is a great problem to have. This is something where God is answering our prayers to rescue victims of trafficking. Now we're saying, Lord, will you answer our prayers with another home?

TAMMY: Here's the incredible news today that our mission partners have found property. All we need to do is help raise some funds today, right now, to help renovate this home that will provide for up to about 50 girls. Which to me is incredibly exciting.

So, if the Father is speaking to you right now to come alongside us and partner with us in continuing to restore this incredible space that the Lord has given us as the family of God to help restore one life at a time, then come on. Come along with us. Let's do it together.

Studio appeal:

JAMES: Tammy, I know you watch these, and I want to thank you for the way you've planted your life, not only on Life Outreach, but on the mission field. I know how burdened you had to be when you saw the potential to take these girls, Betty, and put them in a facility that's nicer than any place they probably have ever seen.

Would you help us right now? Would you help us raise the half-million dollars or so? We've already raised about half, not quite. Maybe a little over half of what we needed, but we need a half million now to complete it so we can start moving them in.

Father, please, please, people that could give thousands of dollars, please inspire them to do it and enable them to do it gladly; in Jesus' name.

If you can give \$128, and rescue a child, if you can, give \$1280 and rescue ten, I don't know what your ability is or what God's leading you to do, but I believe he's leading you to do all you

can. Betty, I'm just praying that we will have the most unbelievable response. Just think what it's going to be like if we're able to tell 50 girls right now that have no place to stay, they found them, I'm sure they may be shuffling them around just trying to hold on. If they get that place, they got a place. Betty, we have seen what happened at Destiny House. That was where we started. That's got to be one of the greatest rescue places on the planet. Boys' and girls' lives rescued from sexual predation and sexual bondage. Thank God!

Would you please, right now, would you ask God, what do you want me to do? Would you get your checkbook and write the largest check you can? Would you get your bank card and use it like a check? Please do that. I want you to look and see some of the things that our missionaries encounter that just really, really tears them up. Right now, I want you to respond to my request, but then in just a little while, I want you to watch what happened to a father, John Yeatts, our mission director. So I know as you see, the way you can help, in the presentation right now, you go and get your checkbook and you get your bank card, and you plan to use it as God directs. JOHN: You look behind me and it sounds like a big party but all I see is brokenness, pain, sorrow, regret, and shame. I can tell you right now there are 1,000 girls right behind me who did not wake up at seven years old and think, I want to do this for the rest of my life. And as a dad, I'm just broken.

Beyond all the lights and everything you see, and as Americans you think people choose this life. No little girl woke up thinking they wanted to be a go-go dancer or a prostitute or a massage bar worker. I'm a dad. Don't tell me that. I know better. Nobody chooses this life. It's chosen because there seems to be no other hope.

If I can grab them all up in my arms and say there is a better way, there is a hope. But this is what I know, Jesus is the better way. It is not this.

Some amazing mission partners are giving their lives, sacrificing everything to help young girls, young boys find a better way. I want to do and I'm asking you to do everything you can to keep them here so that young people can have a better life.

Thank you for helping us. God bless you. We love you. We need you. We need you more now than probably ever before. We need your help.

Studio appeal:

JAMES: John, you're so right. Didn't that tear you up just to see a father?

BETTY: Unbelievable, James.

JAMES: You saw the girls, most of them they're showing you out there are teenagers, but they get them when they're seven, eight, nine, ten, and they start training them. People pay for them. I'm told they may pay more money for the even younger ones. I can't imagine!

Listen to me. God loves all these children so much, and God wants to pour his love through a yielded source that says to the Father, Father, I want your heart, I want your love, and I want your will to be done. You sent your Son to rescue all of us from being destroyed by the deceiver, by Satan, by the murderer. You sent him, and through us, God, we can set others free because of what you've done. We've done, Betty, we've spent 35 years of our life on the mission field. We spent nearly 20 years in the sexual predation world, let's say, of trying to set these precious little ones free. We get them when somebody else is about to get them, and we keep them from ever getting caught, and we build a life for them. It makes everything new because that's what God's love does. And then those that are much older, we rescue them. Betty, that's why this beautiful facility, I can't imagine us having a facility like that building; that if we just finish it out, we just need about a half million dollars to finish it. We could move 50 girls in there tomorrow. They're ready. Imagine! They got a home and a place, and I know we could expand. We'd be trying to get the government and the people over there and say whatever it takes, we want to use it to its maximum ability. Because that's how we think, that's how the missionaries think. But we need your help. I ask you to make the largest gift you can. Let's finish that facility.

BETTY: I sit here, and as I watched this whole show, my heart's been touched, and my heart is broken for these young girls that are, against their will, taken into this captivity. They're put in these small rooms with a little cot or bed, whatever they call it, and they lay there and they wait and watch, who's going to walk through that door next and take advantage of me? Who's going to abuse me? And they can't rest. They never have a night of rest.

But we can provide that for them. We can show them Jesus' love, what real love is about. Give them a place to lay their little heads, that they might rest in God's peace and wake up in the morning refreshed with sunshine on their face and a smile, knowing they don't have to be attacked again. Thank you for joining with us. I know you will. Your heart's been touched. So join with us and let's save these precious children.

JAMES: Please go and get your bank card. Use it like a check. Get your check, write the best check you can. We can set these precious ones free.

Betty, do you know that we've set thousands of little children, and then those that grew up in sexual trafficking totally free? They have become leaders in their nations now because they found life through the love of God and through the love expressed by the viewers of *Life Today*. You're miracle workers. The greatest miracle, these trafficked children, these trafficked girls and boys will ever experience starts with your love gift, and the missionaries' arms around them. Please make the best gift you can.

Open Captions : Nearly 5 million women, girls, and boys are victims of sex trafficking.

>> Even after these children are found, the journey does not end there. These children need more than just rescue. They need love, support, and encouragement to heal from the trauma that they've endured. They need a safe haven, a place where they can rebuild their lives. I've seen firsthand the difference that a loving family can make in the lives of

these children. Every step of this journey requires our unwavering commitment. It's a shared responsibility to rebuild what was stolen: Their childhood, their dreams, and their sense of self-worth.

Together, you and I can be a voice for the voiceless, a force for change, for justice, for healing. Together we can dismantle the chains of child trafficking and light a path toward freedom. We know it is a long road but we are making a difference one child at a time. Will you stand with us as we champion the rights and dignity of every child?

I'm telling you the door is open for us to reach far more than we've even presented to you today. You're the ones that enable us to do it.
